

UPDATE: Weekend Utility work on Simcoe Street and Richmond Street

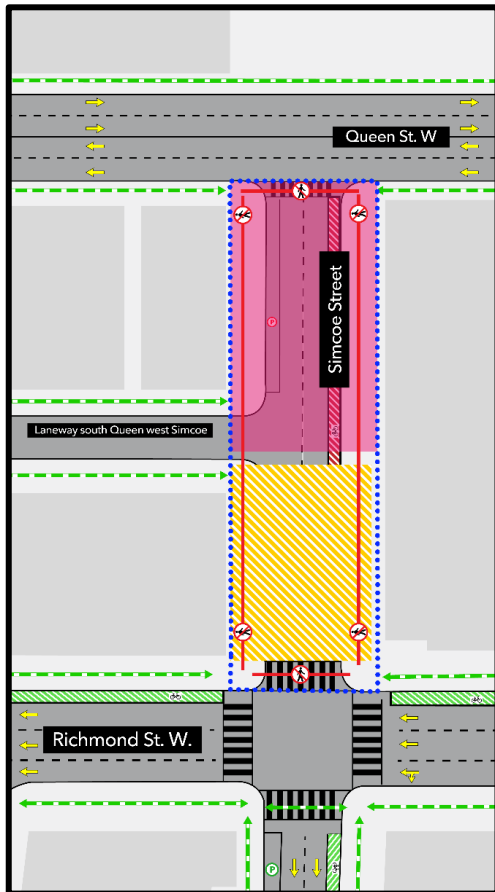
Expected start date: February 21, 2025

Expected duration: March 8, 2025 - March 13, 2025

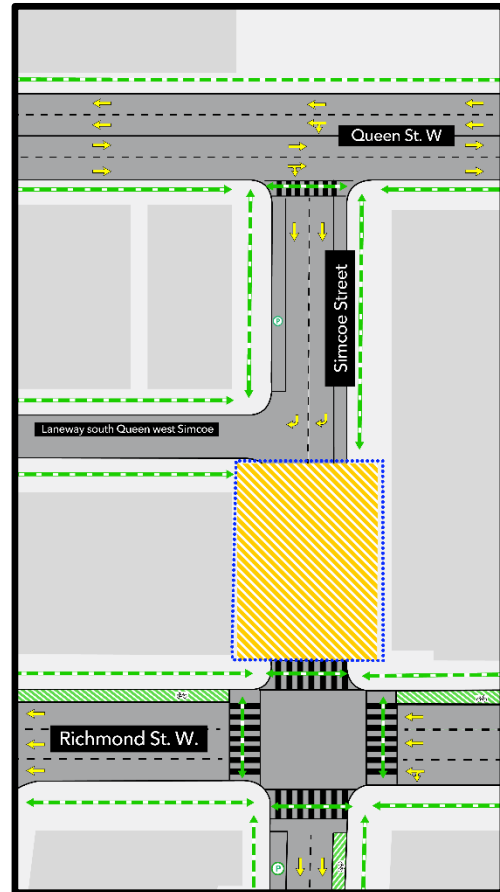
Hours of work: Daily from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Please note: On Sunday, March 9, 2025, crews will temporarily close the curb lane on Richmond Street for 5 hours, from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This curb lane will re-open at noon.









Full road closure (March 8 and 9):

What is happening?

- To facilitate the construction of the future Osgoode station, Toronto Hydro crews will install underground hydro assets.
- This work is required to provide temporary power to the construction site.
- UPDATE:** In order to expedite installation of this critical infrastructure, Toronto Hydro crews will be working on Saturday, March 8 and Sunday March 9, 2025, in the fully closed Simcoe Street, as indicated in the graphic above.
- From Monday, March 10, until Thursday, March 13, there will be a partial closure of Simcoe Street, as indicated in the graphic above. Access to the laneway will be maintained from Monday to Thursday.
- Crews will be working Saturday, Sunday and Monday to Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00pm.
- On Sunday, March 9, 2025, crews will temporarily close the curb lane on Richmond Street for 5 hours, from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This curb lane will re-open at noon.
- During work hours, bike lanes and sidewalk closures will be required as outlined above.

What to expect

- **Crews will start their shift on Saturday, March 8 at 7:00 a.m.**
- **Work is expected to be completed by Thursday, March 13, 2025. Work will wrap up each day at 7:00 p.m.**
- Area residents and businesses can expect to hear noise from work equipment, specifically:
 - Coring drills, hydrovac trucks, concrete trucks, saw cutting and excavators.
- Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Signage will be in place to direct traffic and pedestrians.
- There will be temporary road closures, sidewalk closures and bike lane closures as noted.
- Flag persons will be onsite to provide direction and to ensure the safety of traffic and pedestrians as they navigate the area.
- This work will not impact TTC service. After every work shift, the area will be securely covered and marked for safety until workers return or the work is complete.

Note:

- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.
 - Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
