
# Updated work hours: Underground support structure installation on McCowan Road north of Ellesmere Road

**Start date:** End of November 2024 - Mid-August 2025 **Updated hours of work:** Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.. Saturday and Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., as required.

Note: Work may be delayed due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.





# What is happening?

- Starting in January 2025, crews will begin constructing an underground support structure near FreshCo on McCowan Road, just south of the future Scarborough Centre station.
- The work is located on the east side of McCowan Road, between Bushby Drive and Ellesmere Road, as shown on the map.

# Vehicle and pedestrian diversions

- Traffic lanes on the east side of McCowan Road will be closed to accommodate the work area. All traffic will be diverted to the west side of McCowan Road, with two lanes each for southbound and northbound traffic.
- Pedestrians wishing to walk on the east side of McCowan will be diverted to the east side of the work site, as shown on the map. Concrete and steel barriers and ramps will ensure the detour is accessible and safe. Flaggers will also be present.
- Pedestrians wishing to cross McCowan Road will be able to do so on the south side of the FreshCo and AllStar Wings & Ribs intersection, as shown on the map.

# What to expect?

- Expect noise from the on-site construction equipment, including a front-end loader, trucks, piling rigs, and other machinery.
- Crews will aim to complete high-impact work before 9:00 p.m. on weekdays. However, some activities may extend beyond this time if necessary.
- Weekend work on Saturday and Sunday work will only take place as required.
- Traffic barrels, fencing and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- To ensure pedestrian and driver safety, construction crews will occasionally temporarily close traffic lanes and sidewalks along McCowan Road. Signage will alert drivers and pedestrians to these temporary closures and detours.
- Please take care when travelling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing pedestrians.
