We will be installing multiple noise walls along King-Vaughan. This work will be conducted during daytime hours Monday to Friday.

What to Expect:

Contractors will be working to install several noise walls around the station, primarily along Keele and MacDonald streets. Residents may experience noise and vibration from the use of heavy construction equipment including concrete trucks, a skid steer, a generator, and drill rigs. These noise walls will help reduce sound volumes associated with the passage of trains and future works.

Pedestrian/Commuter Impacts:

No impact as work will take place along the corridor.

Community Engagement:

Our best efforts will be made to have equipment only running when in use to reduce idling noise. Drilling work will only occur during the daytime to mitigate noise disturbances.

We understand that conducting work near a residential area is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this work as efficiently as possible to get things back to regular
