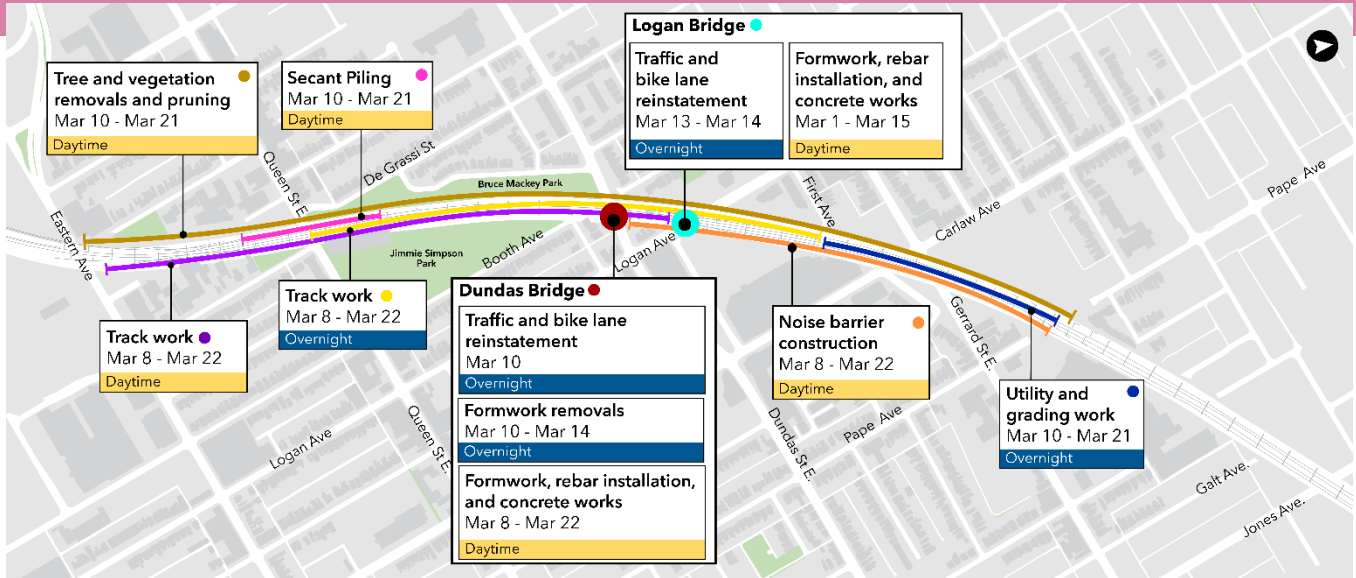


Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Weekly In-Corridor Work Update

Update for the weeks of: Saturday, March 8 to Saturday, March 22, 2025

Hours of work:

- Daytime: Monday- Friday, with occasional weekend work, from 7 a.m.- 7 p.m.
- Overnight: Monday - Sunday from 8 p.m.- 5 a.m. (nights of work depend on activity - further details below).










This notice provides an update on the work happening in the rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. It is updated every Friday.

What is happening?

Construction work is underway in the Lakeshore East rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the rail corridor. The Contractor will be moving equipment and machinery throughout the rail corridor to access each work area and stockpile materials. The Contractor will enter the rail corridor from the access road at Eastern Avenue. Certain construction activities may cause noise and vibration at nearby properties. **For further details, please carefully review the information provided in the table below.**

Mar 8 - Mon. Mar 10.</p>	<p>Track work</p> <p>Delivering and stockpiling tracks in the rail corridor and welding new tracks together. Backfilling and laying material (crushed stone) underneath the tracks.</p>
<p>● Monday, March 10 to Friday, March 21, 2025 (weekdays)</p>	<p>Within the rail corridor between Thackeray St. and Pape Ave.</p>	<p>Utility and Grading Work</p> <p>Installing a raceway conduit in the rail corridor and performing grading work.</p>
<p>● Monday March 10 and Thursday March 13 to Friday March 14, 2025</p>	<p>Mon Mar 10: Dundas Street</p> <p>Thurs Mar 13 to Fri Mar 14: Logan Avenue</p>	<p>Traffic and Bike Lane Reinstatement</p> <p>Crews will be removing the traffic lane closures on Dundas Street and Logan Avenue. Bike lanes will be reinstated once this work is completed. Sidewalk restoration work will take place.</p>

 Monday March 10 - Friday March 21, 2025 (weekdays)	In certain locations along the west side of the Lakeshore East rail corridor between Eastern Ave. and Pape Ave.	Tree and vegetation removals and pruning Removal and pruning of trees and shrubs, as well as clearing and grubbing. Vegetation removal will continue until March 31, 2025, to make way for infrastructure enhancements including new retaining walls and noise barriers.
 Saturday, March 8 to Saturday, March 22, 2025 (weekdays and weekends) 	Dundas and Logan bridges	Formwork, rebar installation, and concrete works Sat Mar 8 & Sun Mar 9: Logan bridge waterproofing work Mon Mar 10: Periodic sidewalk closures on Dundas Street for bike lane reinstatement work.
 Monday, March 10 to Friday, March 21, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor north and south of the Queen Street bridge	Secant Piling at Queen bridge Drilling piles for the future Riverside-Leslieville Station. A drill rig will be used to complete this work.
 Saturday, March 8 to Saturday, March 22, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Dundas Street and Gerrard Street.	Noise barrier construction Drilling posts and installing noise barrier panels. *Compaction work will be taking place on Sun Mar 9 between Dundas and Logan bridges. Residents in nearby properties may experience vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits.
 Saturday, March 8 to Saturday, March 22, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Eastern Ave. and Logan Ave.	Track work Delivering and stockpiling tracks in the rail Corridor and welding new tracks together.

What to Expect

- Overnight work is required to complete activities that construction crews cannot do safely while trains are active and running in the corridor.
- Noise from trucks and equipment entering the rail corridor at Eastern Avenue.
- Excavators, trucks, compactors, loaders, skid steers, and mobile cranes will be used to complete daytime work activities.
- Residents in nearby properties may experience noise and vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits.
- Various mitigation measures will be implanted to reduce disruption.
- Overnight site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
