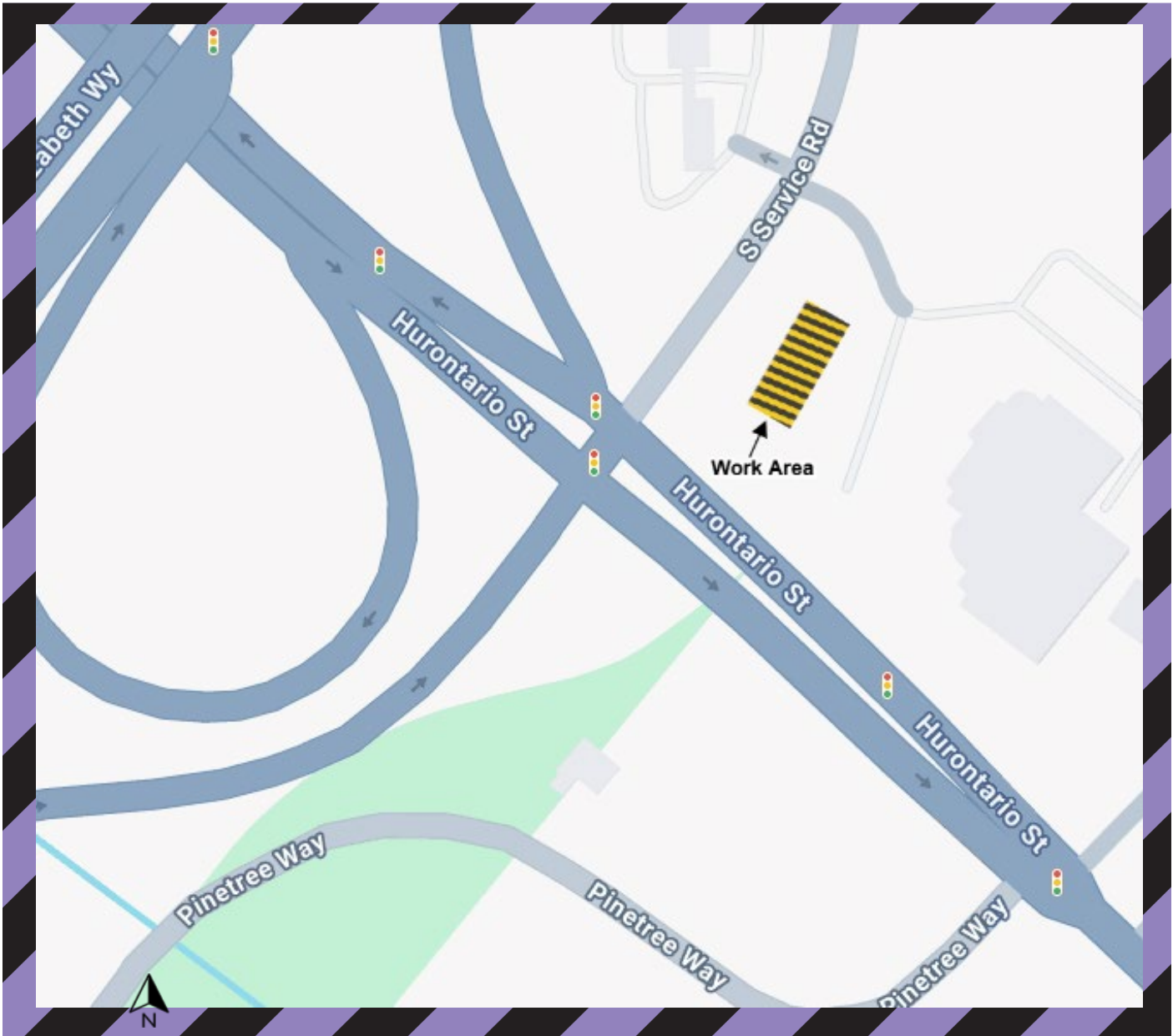


Overnight Traction Power Substation Delivery at South Service Road and Hurontario Street

Estimated duration: February 24, 2025



What work is taking place?

Traction Power Substations (TPSS) will be placed along the corridor, providing electricity to the light rail vehicles for the Hazel McCallion LRT. TPSS 2 will be delivered on Metrolinx lands adjacent to the parking lot at 1599 Hurontario Street, located at the southeast corner of Hurontario Street and South Service Road.

The delivery is scheduled to take place overnight, beginning after 7 pm on February 24, 2025. The South Service Road driveway entrance is anticipated to be blocked for approximately 20 minutes while the TPSS unit is delivered within the staged construction area. While there may be a brief impact on the driveway at 1599 Hurontario Street from South Service Road, there are no additional anticipated impacts to property access or parking spaces. Private access to Hurontario Street is available for vehicles needing to access the Parking lot at 1599 Hurontario during these works. Paid duty police officers (PDOs) and flaggers will be onsite to minimize any traffic impacts and to ensure the safety of the delivery operations. All work is being done on Metrolinx lands within the staged area. Temporary fencing is already in place to mark out the work zone.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- TPSS installation delivery is scheduled to begin at 7 pm on February 24, 2025, with unloading taking place into the overnight hours. Work is expected to be completed by 10 a.m. on February 25, 2025.
- The South Service Road driveway to 1599 Hurontario will be impacted briefly as the truck delivers the TPSS unit within the staged construction area for approximately 20 minutes overnight.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be no significant closures to the right of way (ROW) including Hurontario Street and South Service Road.
- Paid duty police officers (PDOs) and flaggers will be onsite to minimize any traffic impacts and to ensure the safety of the delivery operations.
- Private access to Hurontario Street is available for vehicles needing to access the Parking lot at 1599 Hurontario during these works.

- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work sites.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
