

EXTENDED: Construction hoarding installation on Simcoe Street at the Osgoode south station site

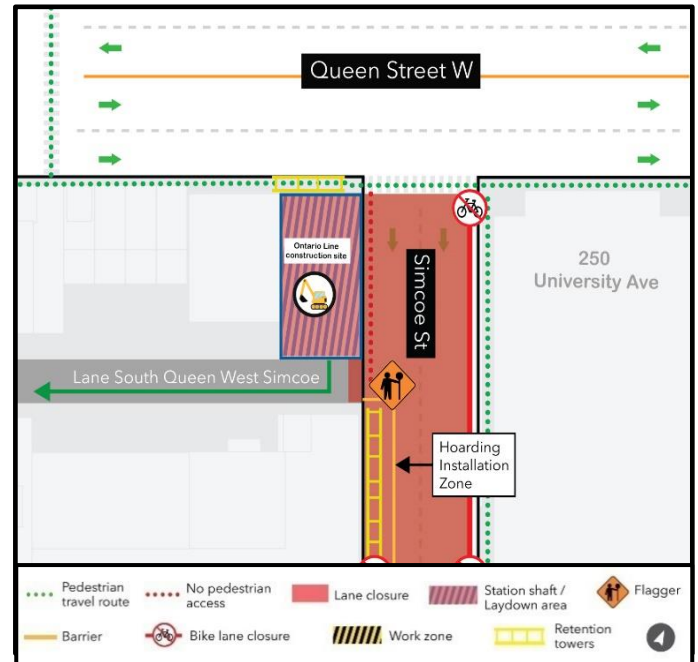
Expected start date: As early as March 10, 2025

Duration: Up to Mid-April 2025

Hours of work: Overnight, weeknights and weekends (as required) from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

What is happening?

- To support ongoing construction of the new Ontario Line station interchange at Osgoode Station, crews will be installing plywood paneling around the relocated heritage wall currently housed south of the Lane South Queen West Simcoe Street between Queen Street West and Richmond Street. The hoarding wall will help create a safer work zone and protect the public as construction progresses.
- This work was temporarily paused for other critical tasks and has now resumed. It will continue overnight from **9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. on weeknights and weekends** (as needed) and is expected to take up to **two more weeks to complete**.
- The existing temporary metal fencing will be removed and replaced with plywood paneling (hoarding).
- While work will take place within the Ontario Line worksite at Queen Street West and Simcoe Street, **area road closures** are required to facilitate the safe completion of this work.
- The following closures will be in place:
 - Simcoe Street remains closed overnight from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. during weekdays (Monday to Friday) and fully closed for a 48-hour period (Saturday and Sunday) during weekends.
 - The access to Simcoe Street from the Laneway South Queen West Simcoe will also be closed. Access to Laneway South Queen West Simcoe will be accessible via Duncan Street.



What to expect

- Flag-personnel will be on site as required to ensure the safety of pedestrians.
- Noise from various construction equipment, and hand power tools equipment such as drills. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Work may be postponed, extended or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
