
Tree removals on Langley Avenue and Pape Avenue

Expected start date: As early as March 21, 2025

Expected duration: Two (2) days

Hours of work: Friday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What is happening?

• To accommodate upcoming sewer and water main relocation works on Pape Avenue and Langley Avenue, crews will remove eight (8) trees on Langley Avenue and Pape Avenue south of Riverdale Avenue, as outlined in the graphic above.



- All trees to be removed are within the public right-of-way or on Metrolinx-owned property.
- Tree removals will occur outside of bird breeding and nesting periods in accordance with the federal *Migratory Birds Convention Act*, the provincial *Endangered Species Act* and the provincial *Conservation Authorities Act*.
- Our vegetation guideline requires planting 1 to 50 trees for every one removed, depending on the tree's size and location. Typically, three trees are planted for every one that is removed. This ensures more trees are planted than removed as we carry out the largest transit expansion in the history of the region.
- Metrolinx is working closely with the City of Toronto and Toronto and Region Conservation
 Authority on replanting trees in the area, where possible. Learn more at

What to expect

- Tree removal work will take approximately two days. Trees in proximity to the Pape Avenue Junior Public School noise wall will be removed on Saturday, while the rest will be removed on Friday.
- One tree will be removed on the south side of Langley Avenue and seven trees will be removed on Pape Avenue.
- Trees along the west side of Pape interface with the existing noise wall. They will be removed
 without affecting the noise wall but may require the temporary removal of some fencing during
 works.
- During removals, crews will occupy a single lane on each day as shown in the graphic above. Lane occupancies and equipment will be demobilized from the road at the end of each day.
- Work will take place during weekdays from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and on Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Sidewalks will be temporarily closed in the vicinity of removal work.
- Noise from construction equipment can be expected, including saws and dump trucks.
- This work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
