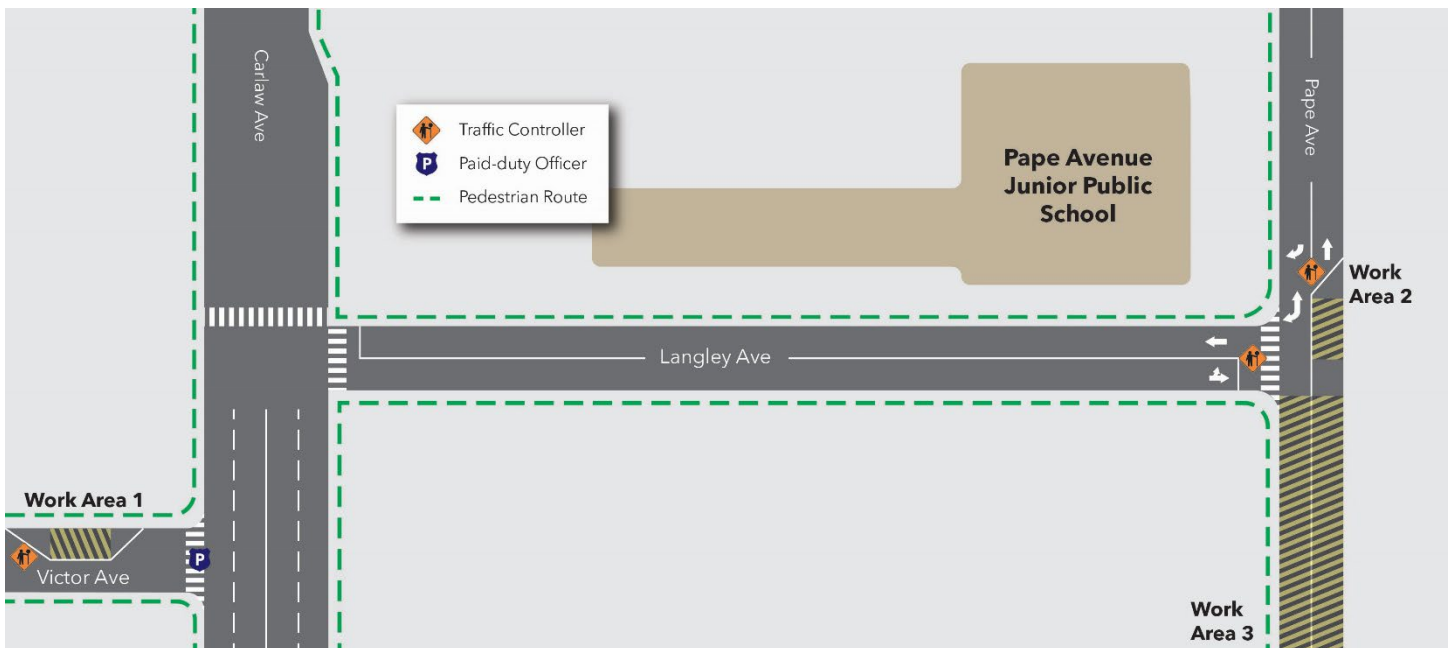


Telus Cable Removal

Expected Start Date: March 11, 2025

Expected Duration: One (1) day

Hours of work: 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.



What is Happening?

- Telus is finalizing their cable work in the Pape-Langley neighbourhood and will be mobilizing for one day to remove old cables from their manholes in the Pape-Riverdale neighbourhood.
- Crews will occupy curbside lanes in three separate work areas, shown above.

What to expect

Construction

- Crews will stage at three existing manholes: one at Victor Avenue and Pape Avenue, one at Pape Avenue and Langley Avenue, and one within the existing closure area on the south end of Pape.
- Work will involve the use of cube vans, pick-up trucks and reel trailers. This is a requirement to safely protect existing utility infrastructure.
- Residents and businesses in the area may hear noise caused by work equipment. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Traffic and Pedestrian Details

- All pedestrian pathways will remain open throughout the work.
- Bi-directional traffic will be maintained around work zones, facilitated by traffic control personnel
