

Updated work hours: Underground support structure installation

Schedule: December 2024 – Mid-September 2025

Updated hours of work: In March 2025, work will be conducted Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Saturday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Note: Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What is happening?

- Starting in December 2024, crews began constructing an underground support structure near the location of the future emergency exit building on McCowan Road, between Ellesmere Road and Hurley Crescent, as shown on the map.
- In March 2025, construction hours will be extended to include Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and will continue to include Saturdays from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- In April 2025, hours will return to the previous schedule: Monday to Friday 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Saturday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Vehicle diversions

- Construction at this site will occur in two phases. For the first phase, traffic will be diverted to the east side of McCowan Road, with one lane of traffic in each direction, as shown in the map above. Traffic will be diverted to the west side of McCowan Road for the second phase starting in March 2025.
- Diversions will be indicated with signage and barriers, and flaggers will be present.

What to expect?

- Expect noise from the on-site construction equipment, including a front-end loader, trucks, piling rigs, and other machinery.
- Traffic barrels, fencing, and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- Crews will aim to complete high-impact work before 9:00 p.m. on weekdays. However, some activities may extend beyond this time if necessary.
- To ensure pedestrian and driver safety, construction crews will occasionally temporarily close traffic lanes and sidewalks along McCowan Road. Signage will alert drivers and pedestrians to these temporary closures and detours.
- Please take care when travelling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing pedestrians. Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained to ensure pedestrian safety.
