
# Nighttime and Weekend Work on Mineola Road

March 22 to 23, 2025 and March 29 to 30, 2025



## What You Need to Know

Crews will be excavating down to the main utility crossing and installing a test station at the southeast corner of Mineola Road and Hurontario Street. This will allow for future testing of the watermain. This work is scheduled to take place on **March 23, 2025, from 7 a.m. until 10 p.m**.

Southbound and northbound traffic on Hurontario Street will not be permitted to turn left onto Mineola Road, and westbound traffic along Mineola Road will not be permitted to turn right onto Hurontario on a red traffic signal during this work. In addition, eastbound traffic along Mineola will also not be permitted to turn left onto Hurontario Street during this work. Paid Duty Police Officers will be on site to assist with traffic needs and safe operation of the intersection.



In addition, crews will also be pulling aerial cables and connecting some properties south of Pinewood Trail along the east side of Hurontario, to the new electrical infrastructure. These connections will take place over two separate weekends: **March 22 to 23, 2025 and March 29 to 30, 2025, from 7 am to 7 pm** each day. Temporary lane closures for these works will reopen after working hours each day, but the sidewalk in the affected area will remain closed until the works are completed.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that properties near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

#### TIMING

- Watermain Chamber work is scheduled for March 23, 2025, from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Aerial cable pulling and connections are scheduled for March 22 to 23 and March 29 to 30, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- PDOs will be on site to ensure the safe operation of the intersection.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

## WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

### TRANSIT DETAILS

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

#### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as the south crosswalk across Hurontario Street will be closed while these works are being completed.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
