


Retaining wall construction at 40 Beth Neelson Dr.

What is happening?

- To prepare for the construction of the Ontario Line's operations, maintenance and storage facility, Metrolinx is building a 115-metre-long retaining wall to provide long-term stability and optimal performance on the building site.
- Metrolinx will also build a temporary access road inside the work site.

- Crews will carry out excavation, ground improvement, and Controlled Modulus Columns (CMC). CMC is a construction method that supports the retaining wall through the installation of vertical concrete columns to enhance soil stiffness.
- Once the retaining wall and waterproofing is installed, the area will be backfilled with soil.

What to expect

- Noise from construction equipment, including excavators and trucks, can be expected.
- A mobile crane will be onsite for some of the work.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zone.
- Sidewalk access and vehicular road traffic will be maintained.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.
