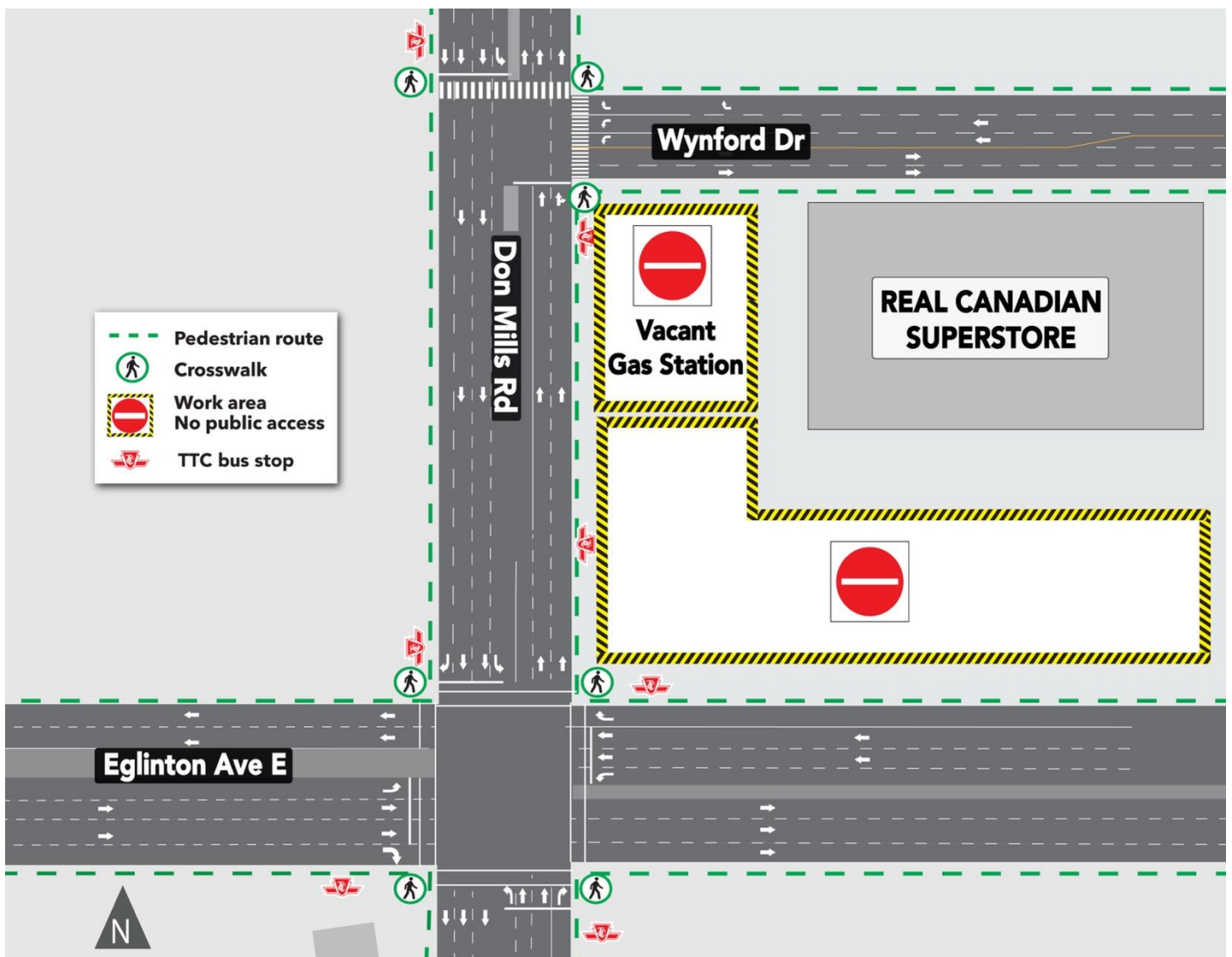


Demolition of gas station and removal of hazardous materials at Don Mills Road and Wynford Drive

Expected start date: As early as April 1, 2025

Expected completion date: July 2025

Hours of work: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.



What is happening?

- In preparation for the upcoming Ontario Line station and elevated guideway, crews must safely remove the vacant gas station structure at 843 Don Mills Road.
- Crews will remove trees within the work area, disconnect underground utilities (e.g. water, gas, hydro) and remove the existing structure.
- A professional team specializing in the handling, extraction and disposal of hazardous materials within the vacant gas station property will conduct this work.
- Hazardous materials such as underground fuel tanks and fuel pumps will be safely contained and secured before being transported to a hazardous waste disposal facility. Hazardous materials will not be left or stored on site.
- This work is scheduled to begin as early as **April 1, 2025, with the expected completion of demolition in July 2025.**
- Following demolition, the site will be backfilled and remain secured for the construction of the future Ontario Line station and guideway.
- Work will take place **from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday.**

What to expect?

- Businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.
- All equipment will be safely secured within the fenced work area.
- Construction hoarding will restrict public access to the site.
- No traffic restrictions will be required for this work.
- Every effort will be made to minimize disruption.
- Public transit will not be impacted by this work.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer car trips on the road each day.
