

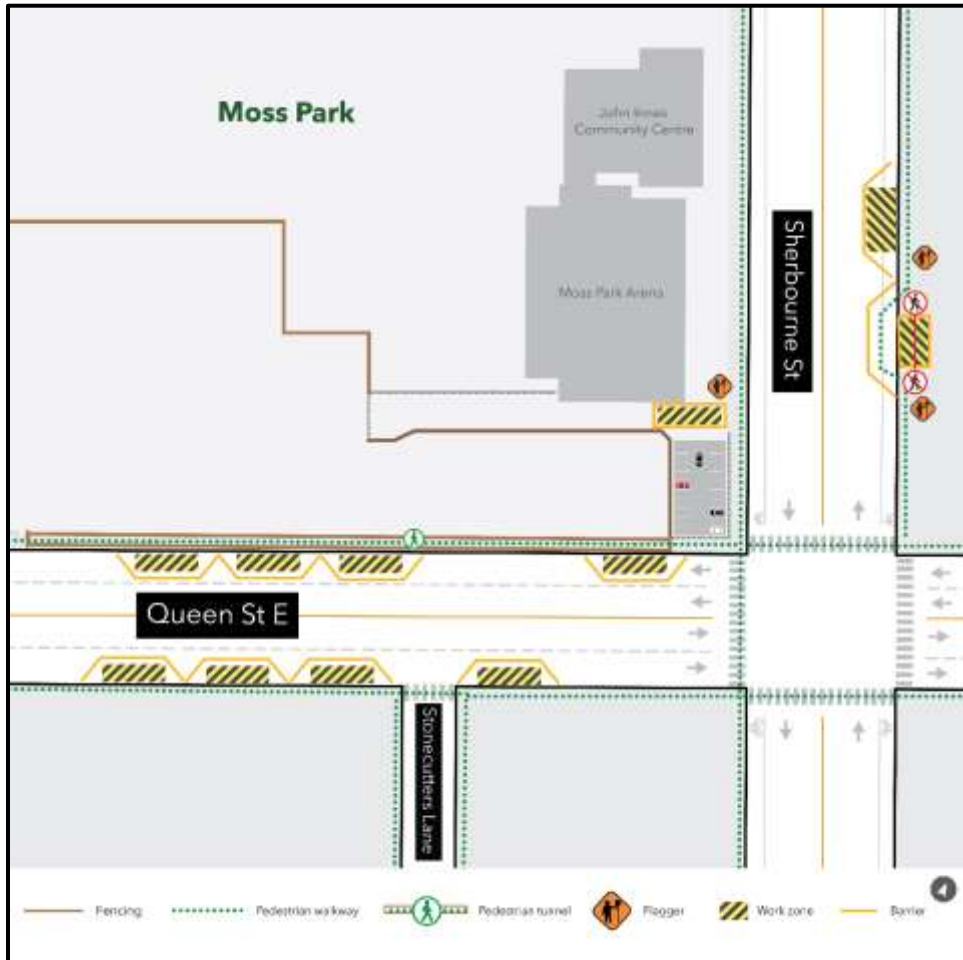
# Installation of monitoring devices: Queen Street East and Sherbourne Street

**Expected start date:** As early as March 17, 2025

**Expected duration:** Up to two (2) weeks

**Hours of work:** Weekdays (Monday to Friday) 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Map of Work Areas: Queen Street East and Sherbourne Street



Monitoring device installations will move around the roadway, with crews working in the identified yellow work zones intermittently.

Installations and lane closures are not expected to occur at the same time. Crews will focus on one location at a time, reopening it before moving on to the next.

## What is happening?

- Crews are installing monitors and investigating utilities around **Queen Street East** and **Sherbourne Street**, as indicated in the areas shown in yellow on the maps above, to support Ontario Line construction work.
- Devices are installed to monitor the area around utilities during construction. They will be installed underground and covered. They are expected to be in place until the completion of the project and may occasionally be revisited by crews for testing and inspection.
- Crews must safely carry out this work with temporary lane and sidewalk closures. They are expected to work intermittently, moving between each work zone in the intersection to complete different segments of work independently.

## What to expect

- The work is scheduled to begin as early as **March 17, 2025**, and is expected to be completed in up to **2 weeks**. Work may be postponed, extended or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- This work will be conducted during **daytime hours starting at 10:00 a.m. and finishing at 4:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday**.
- Area residents and businesses can expect to hear noise from work equipment, specifically hydrovac trucks or drills, as required to assess underground utilities and ground conditions. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.
- All closures for work are temporary and intermittent; areas will only be closed while crews are

surveying the specific areas. The areas will be returned to public use upon completion of the monitoring device installation.

**Queen Street East intermittent partial closures (as noted in the map above):**

- The eastbound and westbound lanes on Queen Street East will be closed intermittently while work is ongoing and will reopen once the work zone is completed.
- Pedestrian passage will be maintained with barriers to separate pedestrians from active work zones where sidewalk closure is required.
- Signage will be posted advising of restrictions.

**Sherbourne Street intermittent partial closures (as noted in the map above):**

- The northbound lane and laneway into Moss Park Arena will be closed intermittently while work is ongoing and will reopen once work is completed.
- Pedestrian passage will be maintained with barriers to separate pedestrians from active work zones where sidewalk closure is required.
- Bike lanes will be maintained and/or rerouted with use of barriers to separate cyclists from active work zones where bike lane closures are required.
- Signage will be posted advising of restrictions.

**Note:** Traffic access may resume before 4 p.m. if work is completed ahead of schedule.

- Transit services will be maintained.
- After each work shift, each area will be securely covered and marked for safety until workers return or the work is complete.
- Residents and businesses near the work zones will hear noise from heavy equipment, including a hydrovac truck, drill rig, and saw cutter.
- All the necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Crews will return to the work zones in the future to perform maintenance on installed devices.
