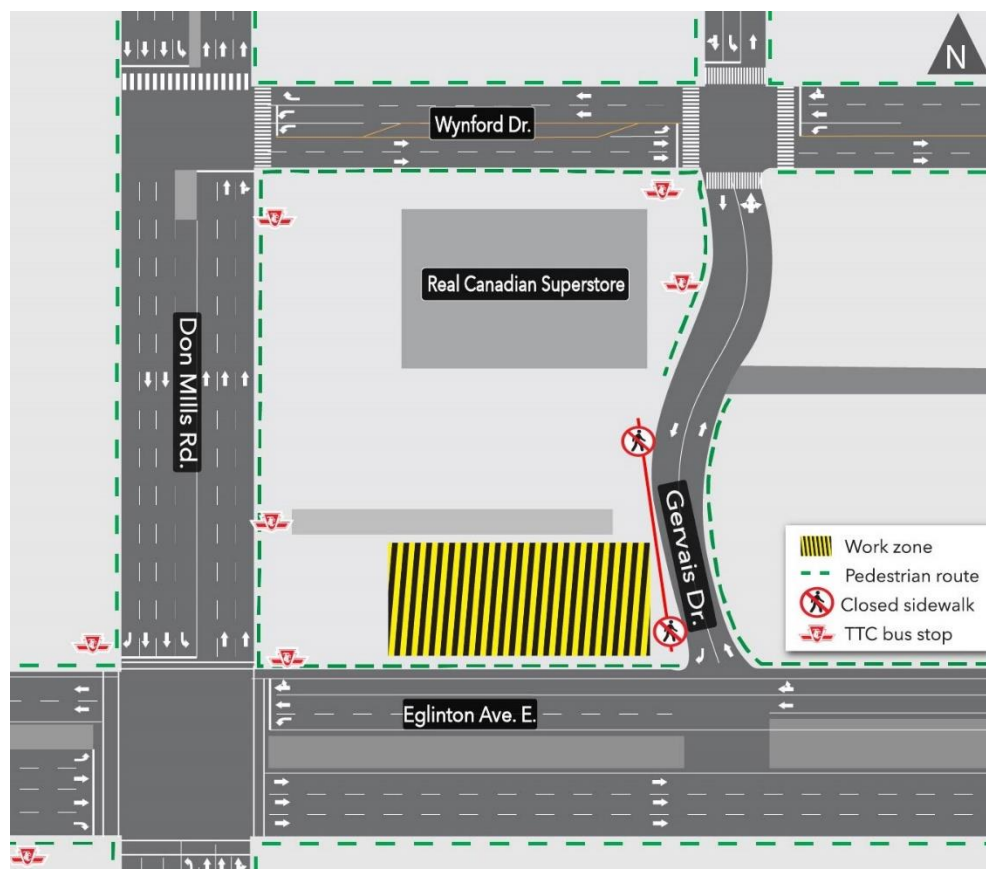


# Temporary bus loop construction at Don Mills Road and Eglinton Avenue East

**Expected start date:** As early as April 7, 2025

**Expected completion date:** Mid-July 2025

**Hours of work:** Weekdays from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.



## What is happening?

- In preparation for upcoming Ontario Line construction, crews will build a temporary bus loop that will allow TTC buses to enter and exit the bus station from Gervais Drive. This modification will create the space needed for construction on the future elevated Ontario Line station connection to the existing Line 5 Eglinton station. Crews will install fencing to secure the work area, where prep work will begin on removing existing curbs and topsoil.
- Construction activities will include backfilling, grading, installing new curbs, sidewalks, bus platforms, lighting and asphalt paving for the temporary bus loop.

- This work is scheduled from as early as **April 7, 2025 to mid-July 2025, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.**

## What to expect

- Traffic lanes will be reduced to one northbound lane and one southbound lane on Gervais Drive (between the Real Canadian Superstore driveway and Eglinton Avenue East).
- Signage will be installed at Gervais Drive and Wynford Drive in advance, to inform motorists about the lane reductions.
- The pedestrian sidewalk on the west side of Gervais Drive will be temporarily closed (between the Real Canadian Superstore driveway and Eglinton Avenue East).
- Signage will be installed to direct pedestrians to walking paths that will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
- Properties near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes and other construction equipment.

## About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer car trips on the road each day.
