


Figure 1: Aerial photograph showing the approximate location of the work zone. Not to scale. For illustrative purposes only.

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What You Need to Know

To support GO Expansion projects, test pit excavations will begin on April 14, 2025, as part of the utility investigation. Work will take place in the designated areas highlighted in yellow and is expected to be completed by April 21, 2025.

This work will not impact commuter access, streets, or railway operations. Activities are scheduled for daytime hours (8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Friday). No work is planned on weekends or on April 18, 2025. Some temporary noise disturbances may occur in the surrounding area during this period.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Use of heavy machinery, including hydrovac equipment.
- Increased presence of construction personnel in the work areas.
- Elevated noise level to the residences surrounding the work area.
- Elevated vibration levels to the residences surrounding the work area.
- All efforts will be made to minimize community impacts.

- 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. (April 14 to April 17 and April 21, no weekend work)
- Please note, dates may be changed due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work will be conducted as quickly and efficiently as possible to minimize disturbances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

• No anticipated impact to traffic in the area.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

 No impact to the commuters accessing Brock Avenue, St Clarens Avenue, Delany Avenue, and Sudbury Street.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

 No impact to the train operations from the near station.
