
Temporary Left Turn Restriction at Square One Drive and Hurontario Street

What You Need to Know

Crews will be surveying the intersection of Square One Drive and Hurontario Street on April 6, 2025, from 7 a.m. until 9 a.m.

Northbound traffic on Hurontario Street will not be permitted to turn left onto Square One Drive during this duration.

TIMING

- Surveying is scheduled for April 6, 2025, from 7 a.m. to 9 a.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Left turns for motorists onto Square One Drive from Hurontario Steet will not be permitted.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.

- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
