### **Moss Park Construction Update**

Work on the Ontario Line's future Moss Park subway station at Moss Park continues, with the crews actively excavating the station shaft to complete this major phase of the construction build.




Diagram of the future advanced Moss Park station excavation.

- Shaft excavation is an essential step in creating a new space for the station subway platform.
- Rock spoils will continue to be raised out of the shaft and transported away using dump trucks, following specified haul routes. Traffic control persons will guide vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists as needed, as vehicles enter and exit the site.
- Primary work hours for spoil removals commence at 6:30 a.m., excavation works take place between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (Monday - Friday) with general shaft and site works between 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- Additional working hours, including periodic weekend work on Saturdays as required between 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Additional work hours may be required to allow teams to complete consecutive works. Advance notice will be provided.
- Working hours are not expected to extend beyond 11:00 p.m.
- Crews will arrive to site prior to the start of works to set up equipment.
- To reduce impacts to residents and businesses in the area, mitigations are in place including air quality, noise and vibration monitoring, street cleaning, site hoarding, additional paved areas, sprinkler systems and mud mats for dust suppression.

#### About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and over 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
