

Notice of extended work hours at Moss Park Station

Expected start date: April 2025

Hours of work: 6:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Monday to Friday with weekend work as required

Expected completion: Remainder of 2025

What is happening?

- To maintain the schedule and progress of station construction and to complete the excavation program, and the start of the permanent works (station build) construction crews will be working extended hours at Moss Park until approximately 11:00 p.m. as required.
- These extended work hours are in addition to the regular Monday-to-Friday schedule, which typically takes place between 6:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- Periodic weekend work will continue on Saturdays between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. as required. Additional work hours may be required to allow teams to complete consecutive works. Working hours are not expected to extend beyond 11:00 p.m.
- Sunday work is not anticipated at this time. If work hours or dates change, the community will be notified in advance.
- Crews will arrive to site prior to the start of works to set up equipment.
- Residents will see cranes, excavators, dozers, dump trucks and various other equipment on-site during this phase of work. Construction noise is expected from the use of these and various other machinery required for this phase of work.
- Increased truck traffic entering and leaving worksites daily is expected, following a specified route.
- To reduce impacts to residents and businesses, mitigations are in place including air quality, noise and vibration monitoring, site acoustic hoarding, mud mats and dust suppression, and no overnight works. *Mitigation efforts vary from site to site.
