
Start of excavation work beside Bruce Mackey Park

Dates: Starting as early as Monday April 14, 2025 until late May 2025 **Hours of work and duration:** Monday to Friday, between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- As early as Monday April 14, 2025, excavation work will begin next to Bruce Mackey Park, across from Degrassi Street and Wardell Street.
- This excavation work is required to install new retaining walls and noise barriers along the rail corridor.
- Excavators will remove the soil within the rail corridor and load material into dump trucks to haul off site.
- As the excavation takes place, tiebacks (steel rods) and wood boards (lagging) will be installed to support the excavation.
- Retaining wall installation will start in late May 2025 after the excavation is complete.




- Solid noise barriers (wood hoarding) will be installed between the rail corridor and Bruce Mackey Park to safely separate the work and mitigate disruption to the community. The barriers will be three metres tall.
- Bruce Mackey Park will remain open throughout the work.
- Excavation will take place Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. and 7p.m.; weekend work may be required to complete critical activities advance notice will be provided for weekend work.

What to expect

- Excavators, loaders, and dump trucks will remove material in the rail corridor
- Tieback drills will be used to install steel rods which will support the excavation
- Construction vehicles will enter and exit the rail corridor from the new access road at Dundas Street (see location on the map)
- Noise and vibration from construction equipment, including excavators, loaders, dump trucks, skid steerers, tieback drills, rollers, and hand tampers can be expected.
- Monitoring instruments are in place to ensure that noise and vibration levels stay within acceptable limits.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zone.

This work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
