

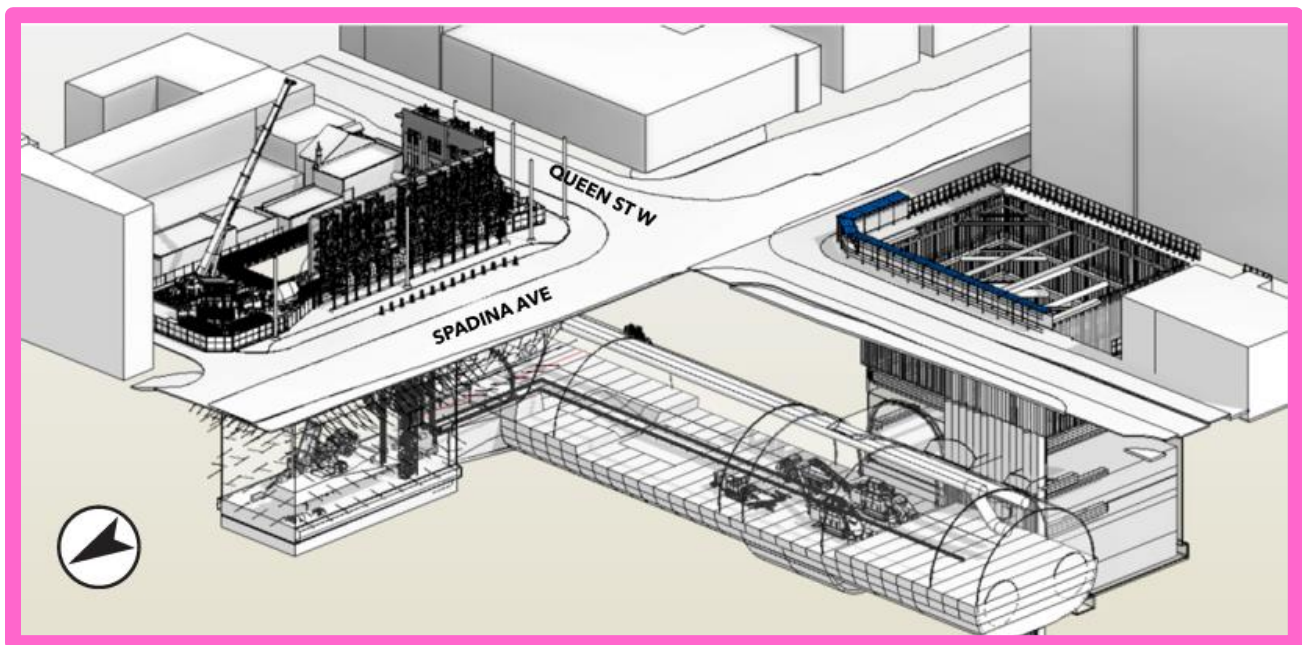
Queen-Spadina South Site Construction Update - April 11, 2025

Starting date: As early as April 8, 2025

Expected completion date: April 24, 2025

Hours of work: Monday to Friday from 7:00 A.M. - 11:00 P.M, Saturday from 7:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.

What is happening?

Excavation has resumed at the south Queen-Spadina station site. Starting as early as **Tuesday April 8, 2025**, work hours on site have been changed to the following:

- Monday to Friday: 7:00 A.M. - 11:00 P.M. Please note crews will arrive on site earlier than 7:00 A.M. for setup and other preparation activities.
- Saturday: 7:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. Please note crews will arrive on site as early as 7:00 A.M. for briefings and preparation work but will not begin excavation until 9:00 A.M.
- Sunday work has been paused for this phase and will only be needed for unforeseen circumstances or other critical requirements.

Initial mitigation measures are in place at the south site, and include:

- Noise-dampening blankets around excavation equipment. Additional blankets will be in place in the coming days.

- Use of a different attachment on excavation equipment where possible. This attachment known as a ripper is expected to be less disruptive, however it cannot be used through the entire site due to space and structural constraints.
 - Where these constraints exist, the original hammer attachment will be in use.
- No work is scheduled for Friday April 18, Saturday April 19, and Sunday April 20. (Easter weekend).

Additionally, crews will be delivering oversized machinery and materials to the south station site. This delivery is expected to take place on April 14, 2025, between 2:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M. Deliveries of this size require overnight hours to avoid traffic and transit congestion.

What to expect

- Noise from excavation work, occurring from 7:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M. on weekdays.
- Reduced hours on Saturday, and no planned work hours on Sunday.
- Flag personnel will be on site to direct the oversize equipment delivery to the south site.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
