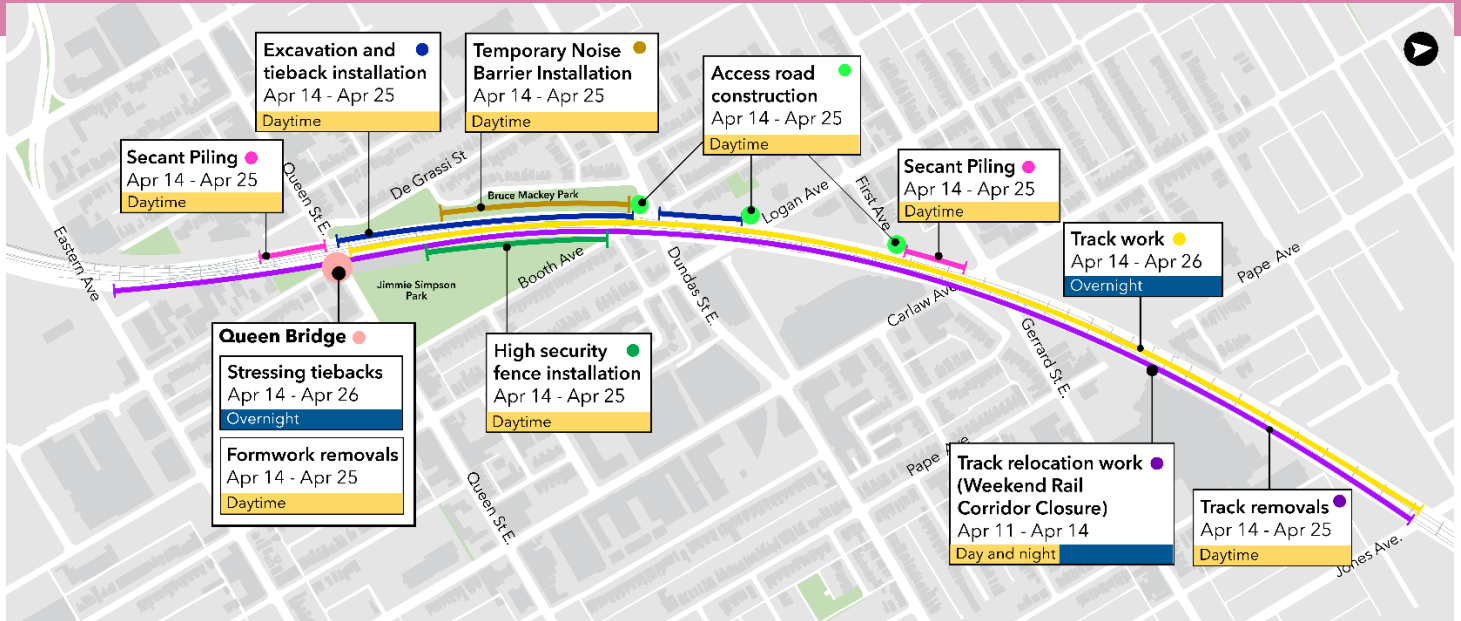


# Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Weekly In-Corridor Work Update

Update for the weeks of: Saturday, April 12 to Saturday, April 26, 2025

**Hours of work:**




- Daytime: Monday- Friday, with occasional weekend work, from 7 a.m.- 7 p.m.
- Overnight: Monday - Sunday from 8 p.m.- 5 a.m. (nights of work depend on activity - further details below).



**This notice provides an update on the work happening in the rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. It is updated every Friday.**

**What is happening?**

Construction work is underway in the Lakeshore East rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the rail corridor. The Contractor will be moving equipment and machinery throughout the rail corridor to access each work area and stockpile materials. The Contractor will enter the rail corridor from the access road at Eastern Avenue. Certain construction activities may cause noise and vibration at nearby properties. **For further details, please carefully review the information provided in the table below.**

 Monday April 14 to Saturday, April 26, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Queen Street East and Jones Avenue.	<b>Track work</b> Removing old tracks with rail saws and lifts. Performing track maintenance work such as welding and rail tie replacement. Stressing
 Starting Friday April 11 at 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Monday April 14	Within the rail corridor between Eastern Avenue and Jones Avenue	<b>Track Relocation Work (Weekend Rail Corridor Closure)</b> Shifting tracks from the west to the east side of the rail corridor. Building new rail, backfilling ballast (crushed stone), and surfacing the new tracks. The Lakeshore East rail corridor will be closed to safety complete this work. GO train service will be affected.  Monday April 14 to Wednesday April 16, 2025	Queen bridge	<b>Stressing tiebacks</b> Pulling tiebacks in the rail corridor using a jack.

Date	Location	Activity
Monday April 14 - Friday April 25, 2025 (weekdays) <b>*Equipment will mobilize to Gerrard-Carlaw bridge on April 25, 2025</b>	Within the rail corridor south of the Queen Street bridge, across from Strange St. and at Gerrard-Carlaw bridge.	<b>Secant Piling</b> Drilling piles for the future Riverside-Leslieville and Gerrard Stations. A drill rig will be used to complete this work.
Monday April 14 to Friday April 25, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Queen St. and Jones Ave.	<b>Track removals</b> Removing old train tracks using rail saws and trucks.
Monday April 14 - Friday April 25, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor north of the Queen bridge, across from De Grassi St. Excavation and tieback installation work will start at Dundas bridge as early as Monday April 14, and at Logan bridge as early as Friday April 18.	<b>Excavation and tieback installation</b> Excavating the embankment within the rail corridor to prepare for retaining wall construction. <b>Periodic concrete breaking will be required during the excavation work - daytime noise can be expected.</b>
Monday April 14 - Friday April 25, 2025 (weekdays)	Queen bridge	<b>Formwork removals</b> Removing timber and steel forms from the bridge.
Monday April 14 - Friday April 25, 2025 (weekdays) <b>Gerrard:</b> Ongoing until April 18 <b>Dundas:</b> Ongoing until April 18 <b>Logan:</b> Starting April 16 until April 23	On the south side of Gerrard Street, west of Carlaw Avenue, on the south side of Dundas Street, east of Wardell Street, and on the west side of Logan Avenue north of the rail bridge (beside 444 Logan Avenue).	<b>Access Road Construction: Gerrard Street, Dundas Street, Logan Avenue,</b> Building three new access roads into the rail corridor. Construction activities will include excavation, concrete breaking, grading, paving and clearing and grubbing.
Monday April 14 - Friday April 25, 2025 (weekdays)	Along the west side of the rail corridor opposite Wardell and Degrassi Street	<b>Temporary Noise Barrier Installation</b> Installing temporary wood noise barriers between the rail corridor and Bruce Mackey Park.
Monday April 14 - Friday April 25, 2025 (weekdays)	Along the west side of the rail corridor at Jimmie Simpson Park	<b>High security fence installation</b>

### What to Expect

- Overnight work is required to complete activities that construction crews cannot do safely while trains are active and running in the corridor.
- Noise from trucks and equipment entering the rail corridor at Eastern Avenue.
- Excavators, trucks, compactors, loaders, skid steers, and mobile cranes will be used to complete daytime work activities.
- Residents in nearby properties may experience noise and vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits.
- Various mitigation measures will be implanted to reduce disruption.
- Overnight site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work locations are subject to change and may vary based on site conditions and/or schedule requirements.
