
Consilium Place road and highway on-ramp closure

Start date/duration: May 1, 2025 to May 5, 2025

Note: Dates may be impacted due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.



What is happening?

- As part of ongoing construction and tunnelling work on the Scarborough Subway Extension project, crews need to temporarily close Consilium Place, from McCowan Road to Corporate Drive, along with the Corporate Drive on-ramp to Highway 401.
- This work is necessary to progress the extension which will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
- This temporary road closure will allow for continuous work under the Consilium Place overpass while the tunnel boring machine passes underneath.
- Once work at this location is complete, the roadways will be reopened as quickly as possible.



Vehicle diversions

- To ensure the safety of both pedestrians and drivers near construction areas, please follow posted signage for pedestrian routes and vehicle detours.
- Drivers wishing to access McCowan Road from Corporate Drive will be diverted south on Consilium Place to Bushby Drive, where they can connect to McCowan Road.
- Drivers wishing to access Corporate Drive from McCowan Road will be diverted to Bushby Drive, where they can connect to Consilium Place and proceed north to Corporate Drive.
- Drivers wishing to access Highway 401 eastbound from Corporate Drive will be directed to the McCowan Road on-ramp via Bushby Drive to McCowan Road.
- Pedestrians can access McCowan Road using the sidewalk connection from Corporate Drive.
- Access will be maintained for residents of Corporate Drive. The northbound lanes on Consilium Place will be converted to a twoway, local traffic-only route to the driveway entrances.
- Diversions and closures will be indicated with signage and traffic barrels.
