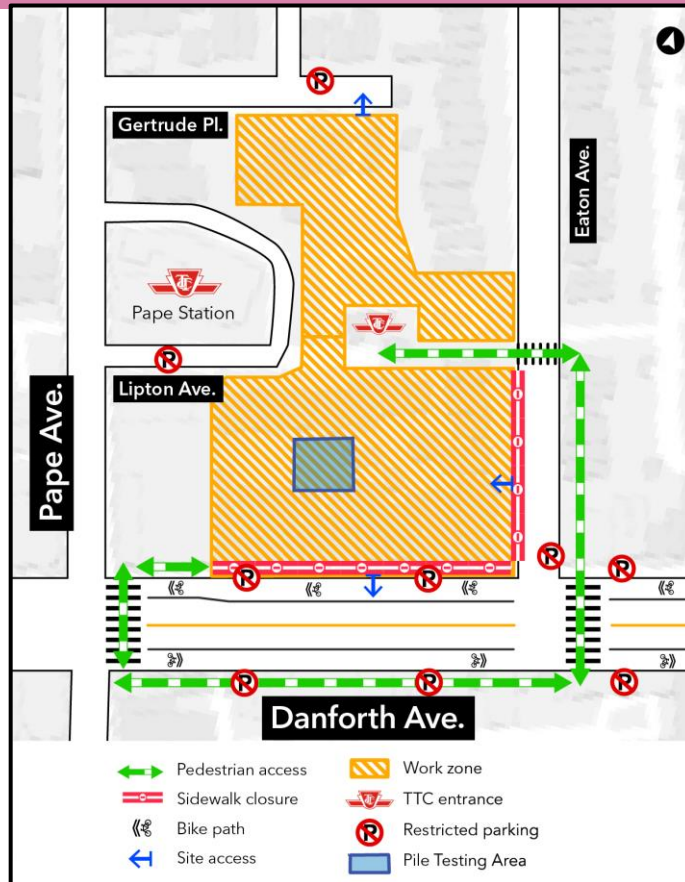


Deep Foundation Pile Testing

Expected start date: April 28, 2025

Expected duration: Approximately two weeks

Hours of work: Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- Starting as early as April 28, 2025, deep foundation pile testing will take place within the site outlined in the map above from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. – see “Pile testing area” in the map above
- In the future, caisson piles will be drilled along Lipton Ave. to support the underpinning of the TTC’s Pape Station. Before this work can happen, GIP is drilling a caisson pile on the east side of the south shaft of the Pape site in order to test the pile’s strength and stability. The test involves applying pressure within the pile using a hydraulic device that pushes upward and downward.
- Drilling will take place during the week of April 28 and the cage install will take place during the week of May 5.

What to expect

- Noise from drilling can be expected.
- Short-term traffic interruptions can be expected while trucks and equipment enter and exit work zones; traffic control personnel will be present to direct vehicles and pedestrians.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Signage and safety barriers will be in place to delineate work zones.
- There will be no impacts to TTC bus or subway service from this work.
- Work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar and bus lines.
- Approximately 40 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
