

Utility work along Yonge Street, from Glen Cameron Road to Clark Avenue

Expected timeline: April 2025 to December 2025

Work hours: Weekdays, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

What is happening?

To support future construction of the Yonge North Subway Extension, crews working on behalf of Metrolinx and Alectra Utilities will be installing underground ducts and upgrading overhead electrical lines. Most of the work will happen along Yonge Street at Glen Cameron Road, extending north past Clark Avenue. This work will help ensure future major construction activities like tunnelling can move forward smoothly.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The project includes five new stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.



The map above shows the approximate location of work zones. It is not to scale and for illustrative purposes only.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Your electricity service is not expected to be interrupted during this work.
- You may experience some increased noise caused by equipment and machinery.
- Access to homes and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Signs will be posted to guide pedestrians, direct drivers, and point to re-located transit stops.
- There will be temporary lane closures on Yonge Street, between north of Glen Cameron Road and south of Clark Avenue

WORK DETAILS:

- Crews will be carrying out different types of work including investigations, excavation along the road, sidewalks and crosswalks, and installing poles and cables.
- Work areas will be restored to their previous condition after the utility work is complete.
- Please note: Work may be rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS:

- Some sidewalks along work areas will be temporarily affected.
- Crosswalks will remain open
- Please follow posted signs to navigate safely around work zones.
- Traffic control personnel will be present as needed to safely guide pedestrians and vehicle traffic.

TEMPORARY BUS STOP CHANGES:

- Some [TTC](#), [York Region Transit](#), and [GO](#) bus stops may be temporarily relocated nearby during the work.
- Signs will be posted at any impacted transit stops to guide you to temporary stop locations.
- For the latest updates on schedules, stop locations, and route changes, please check your transit agency's website.

TRAFFIC DETAILS:

- Traffic control personnel, i will be present as needed to keep everyone moving safely and smoothly.
- Expect minor traffic delays, especially during busy travel times.
