## What is happening?

To support planning and design work for the Yonge North Subway Extension, crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be carrying out geotechnical investigations at 7967 Yonge Street, south of Royal Orchard Boulevard.

## About the Yonge North Subway Extension:

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 subway service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. This project includes five new subway stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometers.

### WORK DETAILS:

- Geotechnical investigations involve drilling holes into the ground – commonly referred to as ‘boreholes’ – to collect samples of the earth.
- The samples provide important data on soil and other underground conditions that inform designs, and construction plans for the project.

### WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Crews will drill three boreholes within the work area illustrated in the image on this notice.
- A truck-mounted drilling rig will be used to drill the boreholes; a truck or van equipped with tools and drilling supplies will also be on site to support the work.
- After work is complete, the boreholes and any disturbed areas will be filled in and restored to their original state.
- A vacuum truck will be used to safely collect and dispose of any water exposed during the work.
- You might hear increased noise levels during work hours. Noise and vibration levels will be monitored and mitigated when necessary.
- The work site will be set up in the morning and cleared at the end of each day.
- Metrolinx Community Engagement team members will be on-site intermittently during the work to help address any concerns.

### HOURS OF WORK:

- Work is scheduled to take place Monday to Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- The duration of work is expected to take place between May 2025 and June 2025.
- **Please note that work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.**

### PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS:

- Work areas will be clearly marked and/or fenced off as required to keep everyone safe.
- Pedestrians should exercise caution around the work area.

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

- There is no expected impact on traffic.

### TRANSIT IMPACTS:

- There is no expected impact on transit service.
