Hydro Cable and Tower Removal

Ongoing to May 31, 2025 (timeline subject to change)



What is happening?

Since March 22, and continuing to approximately May 31, 2025 (timeline subject to change), decommissioned cable lines followed by hydro towers will be removed as part of the Union Station Enhancement Project. Infrastructure has already been removed and relocated on the south side of the Union Station Rail Corridor east of Union Station, as we continue the GO Expansion Enabling Works leading up to the bridge extensions at Lower Jarvis Street and Lower Sherbourne Street. This work will begin in the Don Yard and will continue westward.

What does this mean for you?

Moderate noise and lighting impacts are expected due to the movement and use of construction machinery and equipment, although there will be some hydrovac truck deployment surrounding the foundation removals. Lighting will be needed as each tower is removed. Lighting impacts to residents will be limited. Any roadside impacts will be communicated in advance.
