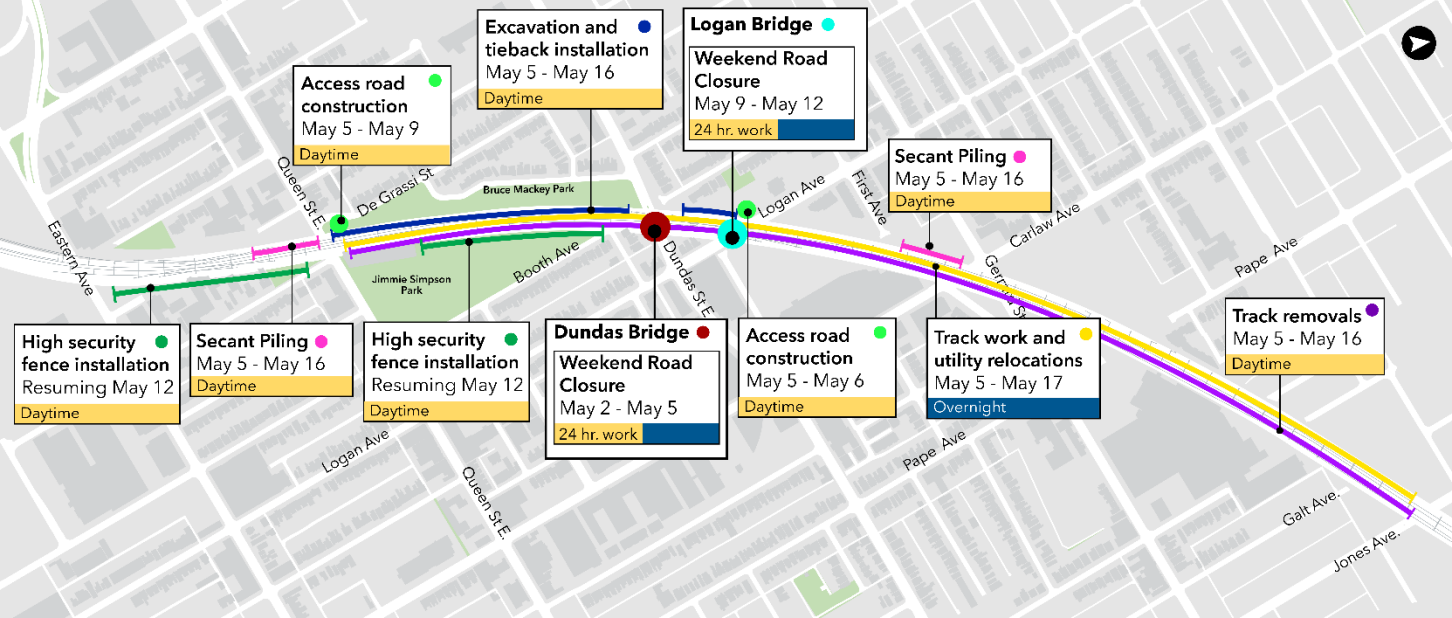


Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Weekly In-Corridor Work Update

Update for the weeks of: Saturday, May 3 to Saturday, May 17, 2025

Hours of work:

- Daytime: Monday- Friday, with occasional weekend work, from 7 a.m.- 7 p.m.
- Overnight: Monday – Sunday from 8 p.m.- 5 a.m. (nights of work depend on activity - further details below).








This notice provides an update on the work happening in the rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. It is updated every Friday.

What is happening?

Construction work is underway in the Lakeshore East rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the rail corridor. The Contractor will be moving equipment and machinery throughout the rail corridor to access each work area and stockpile materials. The Contractor will enter the rail corridor from the access road at Eastern Avenue. Certain construction activities may cause noise and vibration at nearby properties. **For further details, please carefully review the information provided in the table below.**

<div></div> Monday May 5 to Saturday May 17, 2025 (weekdays and weekends)	Within the rail corridor between Queen Street East and Jones Avenue.	Track work and utility relocations Removing old tracks with rail saws and lifts. Performing track maintenance work such as welding and rail tie replacement. Relocating utilit and barriers within the corridor.
<div></div> Starting Friday May 2 at 7 p.m. until Monday May 5 at 5 a.m.	Dundas Street East between Logan Avenue and Broadview Avenue.	Dundas Street Weekend Road Closure Full closure of Dundas Street East beneath the rail bridge to perform demolition work.
<div></div> Friday, May 9 at 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Monday, May 12, 2025	Logan Avenue between Dundas Street East and Gerrard Street East.	Logan Avenue Weekend Road Closure Full closure of Logan Avenue beneath the rail bridge to perform demolition work. Preparatory traffic staging work will take place on nights as early as May 7.

 Monday May 5 - Friday May 16, 2025 (weekdays) *Crews will be doing concrete work in the rail corridor between May 5 to 9. Piling will continue for approx. two months.	Within the rail corridor south of the Queen Street bridge, across from Strange St. and at Gerrard-Carlaw bridge.	Secant Piling Drilling piles for the future Riverside-Leslieville and Gerrard Stations. A drill rig will be used to complete this work.
 Monday May 5 to Friday May 16, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor between Queen Street and Jones Avenue.	Track removals Removing old train tracks using rail saws and trucks. Welding and destressing the rail tracks.
 Monday May 5 to Friday May 16, 2025 (weekdays)	Within the rail corridor north of the Queen bridge, across from De Grassi St. and south of Dundas bridge across from Wardell Street. Excavation and tieback installation starts at Logan bridge on Monday May 5.	Excavation and tieback installation Excavating the embankment within the rail corridor to prepare for retaining wall construction. Periodic concrete breaking will be required during the excavation work - daytime noise can be expected.
 Monday May 5 - Friday, May 9, 2025 (weekdays) Logan: Ongoing until May 6 Degrassi: Ongoing until May 9	On the west side of Logan Avenue north of the rail bridge (beside 444 Logan Avenue) and at Degrassi Street and Queen Street.	Access Road Construction Building two new access roads into the rail corridor. Construction activities will include excavation, concrete breaking, grading, paving and clearing and grubbing.
 Resuming as early as Monday May 12, 2025, for approx. three weeks	Along the east side of the rail corridor at Jimmie Simpson Park and between McGee Street and Eastern Avenue	High security fence installation and restoration work Backfilling, sodding, and seeding

What to Expect

- Overnight work is required to complete activities that construction crews cannot do safely while trains are active and running in the corridor.
- Noise from trucks and equipment entering the rail corridor at Eastern Avenue.
- Excavators, trucks, compactors, loaders, skid steers, and mobile cranes will be used to complete daytime work activities.
- Residents in nearby properties may experience noise and vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits.
- Various mitigation measures will be implanted to reduce disruption.
- Overnight site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- Work locations are subject to change and may vary based on site conditions and/or schedule requirements.
