Tree Removals on Beth Neilson Drive

Expected start date: Mid-May

Expected duration: 1 day

Hours of work: 7:00 a.m to 5:00 p.m



 Trees to be removed

What is happening?

- To establish the necessary working area for the construction of the underpass structure on Beth Neilson Drive, three (3) trees will be removed adjacent to the property at 51 Beth Neilson Drive.
- Tree removal works will involve the use of chainsaws, boom trucks, wood chipping equipment and other machinery.

What to Expect

- Crews will be removing 3 trees from the area outlined in the graphic above. These removals were subject to an Arborist's review.
- Where required, crews will install barriers around nearby trees that are being protected and preserved.
- These tree removals have been scheduled to take place outside of the expected migratory bird nesting season to ensure a reduced likelihood of impacts to wildlife.
- Vibration and noise levels will be measured, and mitigation implemented if exceedances occur.
- Work zones will be marked using signage, safety barriers, and energy attenuators. Construction equipment and materials will be securely stored within designated work zones to ensure safety and prevent unauthorized access.
- There will be no impact on TTC services in the area because of this work.

- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Approximately 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
- 28,000 fewer cars on the road each day.
