
Overnight lane restrictions on McCowan Road at Bushby Drive

Start date/Duration: Week of May 15, 2025 **Hours of work:** Weeknights overnight, 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

Note: Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances





What is happening?

- Starting in early May 2025, crews will begin drilling work for the installation of pressure relief wells, which will support the tunnel boring machine (TBM) as it passes underground.
- The work site will be located on McCowan Road northbound at Bushby Drive, as shown on the map.

Vehicle diversions

- There will be lane restrictions northbound on McCowan Road approaching and beyond the intersection of Bushby Drive.
- Diversions will be indicated with signage and barriers, and flaggers will be present.
- To ensure pedestrian and driver safety, construction crews will occasionally temporarily close traffic lanes and sidewalks along McCowan Road. Signage will alert drivers and pedestrians to these temporary closures and detours.

What to expect?

- Expect noise from on-site construction equipment, vehicles, truck-mounted drills, and other machinery.
- Traffic barrels and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- Please take care when travelling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing pedestrians. Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained to ensure pedestrian safety.

About the project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
