

Lane closures on McCowan Road near Lawrence Avenue East


Schedule & hours of work

Lane closures: May 1 - late August, 2025

Pipe installation & jet grout rig set-up: May 1 - Mid-May, 2025, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekdays

Jet grouting: Mid-May - late August 2025, 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. weekdays

Note: dates may be impacted due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.



What is Happening

- As part of Scarborough Subway Extension construction, crews need to install piping used to carry out below grade ground improvement works under McCowan Road, which will require temporary lane closures.
- Crews will be using excavators, concrete saw cutters, and hydro vac trucks to remove the asphalt and gravel and dig a trench to perform the pipe installation.
- Crews will also be using jet grout rigs to perform below grade ground improvement works.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect

- The work will take place in two stages.
 - Pipe installation under McCowan Road and jet grout rig set-up will occur from May 1 to mid-May
 - Jet grouting work will occur from mid-May to end of August.
- McCowan Road centre lanes will be closed in both directions; at least one lane will remain open at all times.
- Throughout this work, northbound and southbound turns from Lawrence Avenue East onto McCowan Road will be maintained.
- Pedestrian detours will be implemented with barricades and signage to delineate the walkway.
- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off to ensure public and worker safety.
- Nearby residents may hear noise from this construction activity. Crews will be monitoring the activity and will take steps to mitigate noise where possible.

About the Project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
