What is happening?

- Crews are conducting fire hydrant work at Pape Avenue and Lipton Avenue.
- To complete the connection to existing city infrastructure, there will be a water shut off for nine hours starting at 8 p.m. on May 22 to 5 a.m. on May 23.

During the shut off, water service will not be available to the following addresses:

733, 731 and 743 Pape Avenue

• It is recommended that residents at these locations store water for domestic use during this time period.

Note:

- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances. If the shut-off is rescheduled, a new notification will be distributed.

About the project
