

Lane Reduction on Eglinton Avenue West for Utility Work at Mount Dennis Station

Scheduled start: May 20th, 2025

Expected duration: 3 weeks

Work hours: Weekdays, 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- Construction is underway at Mount Dennis Station to build the 500-metre tunnels which will connect the extension to future Line 5 Eglinton service.

Hours of work

- Regular work hours are weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Work may be scheduled outside regular work hours, as required.
- Work may be delayed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

What to expect

- Work is taking place at the Mount Dennis Station Plaza, as well as behind the station adjacent to Hollis Street as marked in the map above.
- To accommodate the work safely, the following lane reduction is in effect:
 - One westbound lane on Eglinton Avenue West from Weston Road to Mount Dennis Station.
- As part of this work, utility relocation and upgrades are required to safely accommodate tunnelling activities.
- A temporary bi-directional cycle track and pedestrian walkway are open for use on the south side of Eglinton Avenue West during construction.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the future Line 5 Eglinton will run 9.2 kilometers from the future Mount Dennis LRT station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
