
# Overnight work near Kennedy subway Station

Schedule: May 29 - June 12, 2025 (weekdays only)

# What is Happening

- As part of the ongoing work on the Scarborough Subway Extension, crews need to complete the foundational work of the TVSEB (Tunnel Ventilation System Electrical Building).
- The TVSEB is critical infrastructure to power the ventilation systems needed, and to ensure high air quality for the Scarborough Subway Extension.

## What to Expect

- Residents can expect to see crews using excavators for the reinforced concrete cutting, as well as a small hydrovac truck to remove debris and reduce dust.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks and other construction equipment. This work will all be taking place within a walled construction zone, minimizing noise.

# **About the Project**

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 farther into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
