

Don Yard Rail Corridor

Bi-Weekly Construction Update

Saturday May 31 to Saturday, June 14, 2025

This notice provides an update on the work happening in the Don Yard rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. The notice will be updated on a bi-weekly basis.



What is happening?

Construction work is underway in the Don Yard rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. A new subway tunnel and portal are being built in the Don Yard to transition the Ontario Line from underground to surface level. There will also be a new bridge constructed over the Don Valley Parkway. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the Don Yard. **For further details, please carefully review the information provided in the table below.**

<div></div> Resuming in mid-June during the daytime	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Middle of the site east of 181 Mill Street towards Bayview Avenue	Piling Using a drill rig to dig circular holes in the ground. These holes are then filled with steel and concrete to create a wall that will support the tunnel excavation. Piling is progressing west to east.
<div></div> <div>Ongoing until December 2025 Daytime<ul style="list-style-type: none">Weekdays and Saturdays from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.<u>Intermittent overnight work as required.</u></div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Full Site	Excavation, hauling and tieback installation and steel bracing (Support of Excavation) Using excavators and dump trucks to remove material (soil) from the site. Using drill to install steel rods that will support the excavation. Milling and smoothing the piles using an excavator. Activities progress west to east.
<div></div> <div>Ongoing until December 2025 Daytime and periodically on evenings<ul style="list-style-type: none">Weekdays and Saturdays from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m.<u>Weekday evenings from 3 p.m. – 11 p.m.</u></div>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">At the east end of the site, beside the Don River	Bridge trestle work Installing the foundations and frame for the temporary bridge trestle. Construction activities include piling, excavation, concrete works, and welding steel beams. *Starting the week of Monday June 9, welding work will take place in the evenings on weekdays between approx. 3 p.m. – 11p.m. No noise is expected.
Nightly Don Valley Parkway Closures June 2, 3, and 11 between 11p.m. – 5 a.m.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">On the Don Valley Parkway (DVP) and Gardiner Expressway between Jarvis Street and Eastern Avenue	Monitoring installation Installing monitoring equipment to support construction of the new bridge framework.
