

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### New layout at Pape and Danforth


- New gate location closer to Eaton Avenue
- Westbound traffic and bike lanes shifted over traffic deck
- Work zone in center of Danforth Avenue (for Danforth jet grouting works).
- Sidewalk on the west side of Eaton Avenue re-opens in mid-June.

- 2. Install deep secant wall
- 3. Install TTC support Caissons
- 4. Excavate Area 1 in stages.



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



# Environmental mitigation strategies moving into the next phase of construction at the Pape site

- On-going monitoring and real-time alerts
- Erosion and Sediment Controls:
  - Paving site
  - Boundary Controls (geotextile fabric to be added along site fence)
  - Mud Mats
  - Applying Water
  - Covers on Trucks
  - Street Cleaning (sweeper truck)
  - Inlet Controls
  - Wheel wash station at Danforth gate (clean truck wheels prior to exit)
  - Raised curb within our site, along Eaton Ave.
- Proposed new sound wall to be installed at some locations.





### **Air, Noise and Vibration Monitors**

- Both of GIP's sites have multiple air, noise and vibration monitors.
- The team receives real time alerts, and all exceedances are reviewed daily.
- Mitigation measures are reviewed and implemented on site based on the monitoring data results.
- Metrolinx is continuing to review if additional monitors are necessary.


# What is Happening?



The existing ventilation system that is located under Pape Station's main entrance is being demolished, relocated and upgraded.



The construction area for the new ventilation system will affect Lane North Danforth West Pape, 77 Gough Avenue (Green P) and 716 Pape Avenue (Green P)

## Why is this Happening?



Pape Station's existing ventilation system is being relocated and upgraded to make room for the future concourse level of the upgraded Pape Station



Ontario Line's updates to Pape Station will allow transit riders to transfer to and from the Ontario Line to Line 2. The existing ventilation system located under Pape Station's main entrance will be demolished and a new structure will be constructed.
