Overnight directional drilling for utility relocation at Beth Nealson Drive

What is Happening?

- Metrolinx will construct an underpass on Beth Nealson Drive for Ontario Line trains to run-at grade while lowering the road for existing traffic
- Before construction begins for the underpass, utility companies will carry out utility relocations.
- As part of these utility relocations, Bell Canada will use a directional drill to install new infrastructure to enable cable relocations.
- Directional drilling work is forecast to begin in June 2 2025 and is projected to be completed in four months.
- Once directional drilling is complete, Bell will conduct cable pulling/splicing, as well as cutover works.
- Additional notice will be shared with the community ahead of the transition to cable pulling work.

What to expect

Construction

- Crews will construct a launch pit on Thorncliffe Park Drive near Pat Moore Drive, as well as a receiving pit further north on Beth Nealson Drive.
- From the launch pit crews will use a directional drilling machine to install new infrastructure towards Wicksteed Avenue.

Traffic and Pedestrian Details

- There will be a single lane closure on Beth Nealson Drive.
- Bi-directional traffic will be maintained throughout work.
- Bi-directional traffic will be maintained by traffic control personnel at either end of the single lane closure.
- The east sidewalk on Beth Nealson will be closed, and pedestrians will be detoured to the nearest crossing points using posted signage.

Safety

- Signage will be posted around the site to direct pedestrians.
- Equipment may be left on site but will be properly secured and stored to ensure safety.

About the Ontario Line

- 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- 15 stops and more than 40 connections to other transit, including GO train, subway, LRT, streetcar, and bus lines.
- Less than 30 minutes from one end of the line to the other.
