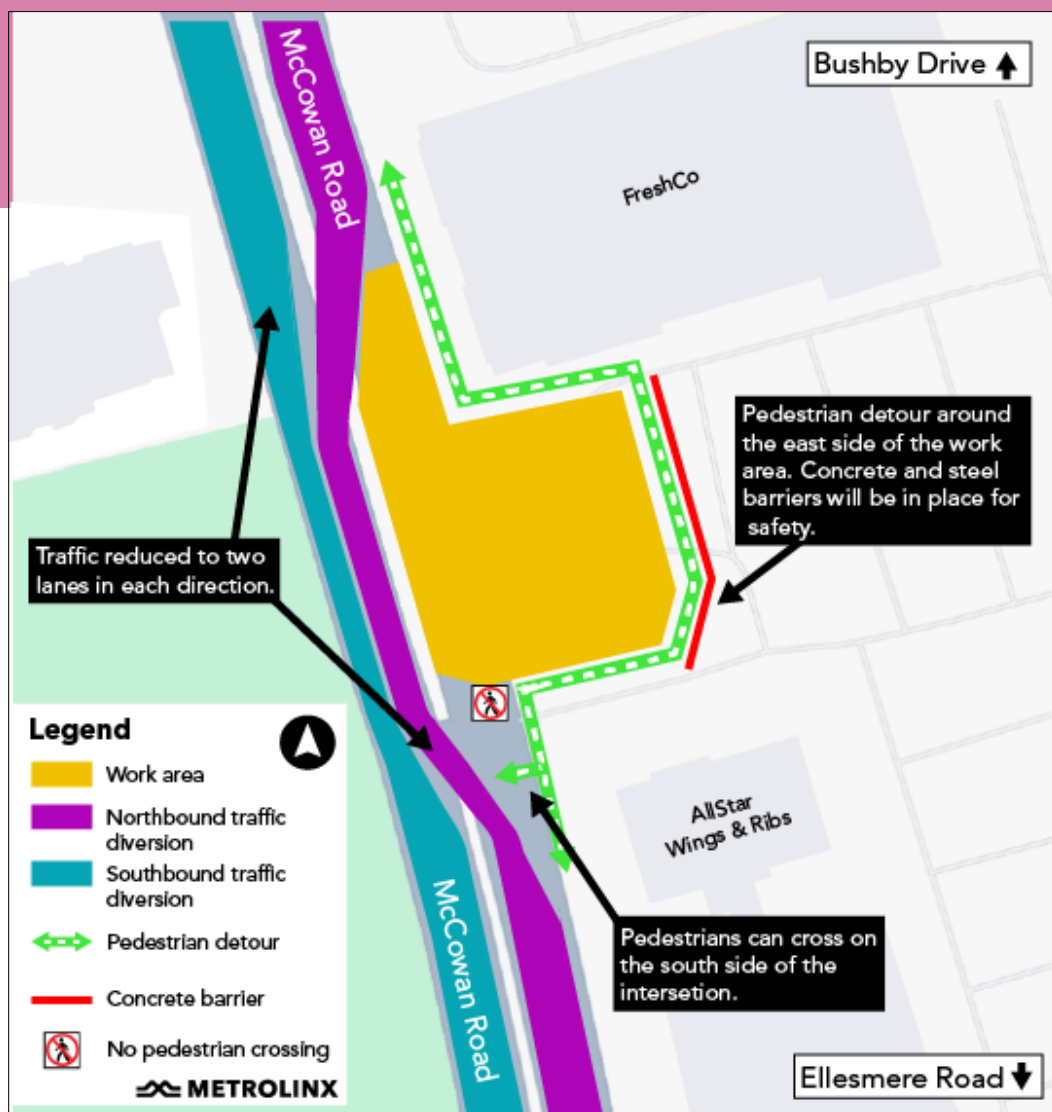


# Updated work hours: Underground structure installation on McCowan Road north of Ellesmere Road

**Start date:** Late June 2025 to early July 2025

**Hours of work:** Regular scheduled work Monday to Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; Sunday 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and overnight as required.

*Note: Work may be delayed due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.*



## What is happening?

- In January 2025, crews began constructing an underground support structure near the FreshCo on McCowan Road, just south of the future Scarborough Centre station.
- This notice reflects an earlier end date than originally planned (early July 2025) and extended weekend and potential overnight work hours as noted above

## Vehicle and pedestrian diversions

- Traffic lanes on the east side of McCowan Road will be closed to accommodate the work area. All traffic will be diverted to the west side of McCowan Road, with two lanes each for southbound and northbound traffic.
- Pedestrians wishing to walk on the east side of McCowan will be diverted to the east side of the work site, as shown on the map. Concrete and steel barriers and ramps will ensure the detour is accessible and safe. Flaggers will also be present.
- Pedestrians wishing to cross McCowan Road will be able to do so on the south side of the FreshCo and AllStar Wings & Ribs intersection, as shown on the map.

## What to expect?

- Expect noise from the on-site construction equipment, including a front-end loader, trucks, piling rigs, and other machinery.
- Crews will aim to complete high-impact work before 9:00 p.m. However, some activities may extend beyond this time if necessary.
- Sunday and overnight work will only take place as required.
- Traffic barrels, fencing and barriers will be in place to separate and secure work zones.
- To ensure pedestrian and driver safety, construction crews will occasionally temporarily close traffic lanes and sidewalks along McCowan Road. Signage will alert drivers and pedestrians to these temporary closures and detours.
- Please take care when travelling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing pedestrians.

## About the project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 further into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options, including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
