

Construction sewer discharge work at Queen Street East


Expected start date: As early as July 3, 2025

Expected duration: Up to eight (8) days

Hours of work: Overnight from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. (weekdays, Monday to Friday)

What is happening?

- As part of ongoing construction of the Ontario Line and the future station site at Queen, crews will be connecting below-ground sewer infrastructure.
- Crews will be excavating the sidewalk at the northeast corner of the Queen Street East and Yonge Street intersection to allow the installation of pipes in the ground. Refer to map for work zones.
- Work is scheduled to occur within two days between July 3rd and July 11th.



What to expect

- The westbound sidewalk will be closed along Queen Street East while work is ongoing and will reopen once complete.
- The northbound crosswalk will be closed at Queen Street East and Yonge Street while work is ongoing and will reopen once work is complete.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained through the 2 Queen building.
- Crews are expected to be on-site prior to 9:00p.m. to set-up equipment.
- Residents will see equipment moving around the work zone and hear construction noise from various machinery including saw cutting equipment and hydrovac trucks required to carry out exposure of underground utilities. Crews will take measures to minimize noise impacts wherever possible.

- Signage will be in place to assist transit users, pedestrians and traffic through the work zones.
- A paid duty officer will be on site to help direct pedestrians.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Additional work hours may be required to allow teams to complete consecutive works.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
