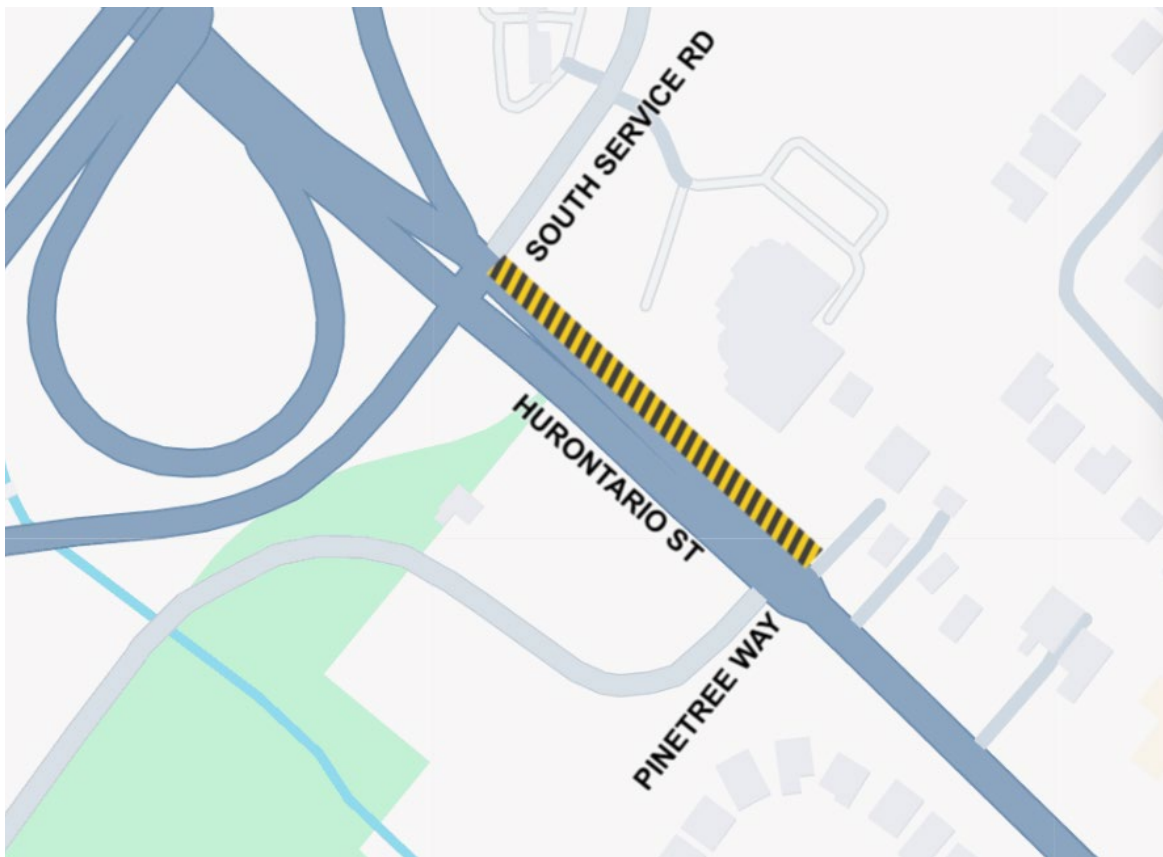


Nighttime and Weekend Electrical Installations on Hurontario Street near Pinetree Way

July 4-6, 2025



What work is taking place?

Crews will be installing cables and electrical connections on Hurontario Street near Pinetree Way. This work is being scheduled during nights and the weekend from July 4-6, 2025 to minimize impacts and to get the work done in efficient manner. The work hours are as follows:

- Friday, July 4 from 5 pm to Saturday, July 5 at 7pm
- Sunday, July 6: 7am to 7 pm

The east sidewalk and one northbound lane from Pinetree Way to South Service Road on Hurontario Street will be closed from Friday July 4, 5pm until Sunday, July 6, 7 pm.

The bus stop on Hurontario Street near South Service Road will be closed. Please follow the signage.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TIMING

- The work is being scheduled during nights and weekend from July 4-6, 2025:
 - Friday, July 4 from 5 pm to Saturday, July 5 at 7pm
 - Sunday, July 6: 7am to 7 pm
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work sites.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- The bus stop on Hurontario Street near South Service Road will be closed. Please follow the signage.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.
- Sidewalk and one lane of traffic near the work area will be closed.


PROPERTY DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
