


Piling work at Mount Dennis Station to support tunnel construction

Expected timeline: July 10, 2025 - January 2026

Work hours: Weekdays and weekends, 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

What is happening?

- Crews working on behalf of Metrolinx will be carrying out piling and excavation work along Mount Dennis Station to support construction of the tunnels for the Eglinton Crosstown West Extension.
- Support structures, such as steel piles, will be used to ensure the ground remains stable and secure for excavation and construction.
- Drilling equipment will be used to drive steel casings into the ground to dig holes.

What to expect

- The work involves the installation of support structures and systems. These are crucial for the construction of the tunnel at Mount Dennis Station that will connect the extension to the future Eglinton Crosstown LRT service. To safely accommodate the ongoing work, the following lane reduction is in effect.
 - o One westbound lane on Eglinton Ave W from Weston Road to Mount Dennis Station
- lane reduction will potentially cause traffic delays. Please plan ahead and consider alternative routes
- Some noise, vibration, and dust can be expected near the construction site during work hours.
- Measures will be taken to minimize disruptions wherever possible.
- Noise, vibration, and dust monitors will be used 24/7.
- Work schedules may extend beyond regular hours, as needed and in line with city working hour bylaws
- Work may be delayed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to the region, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometers from the future Mount Dennis LRT station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
