


St. Clair- Old Weston GO Station: Minor Track Closure, Utility Daylighting & Track Monitoring

July 11 to July 18, 2025



WHAT IS HAPPENING

As part of preparatory works to ready the site of the future St. Clair-Old Weston SmartTrack GO Station for construction, crews will be working within the rail corridor to complete several activities, including utility daylighting, ballast removal, inspections and vibration monitoring.

Two tracks along the Kitchener GO line will be closed from Friday July 11 at 11:59pm to Monday July 14 at 5:00am. One track will remain in service. Construction vehicles and dump trucks will be entering and existing the rail corridor to load and unload materials overnight from 1:30am to 4:30am during the work period.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will complete several activities during this track closure, including utility daylighting, ballast removal, inspections and vibration monitoring.
- All work will occur within the rail corridor with designated access routes for construction staff.
- Crews will be using heavy machinery, including hydrovac trucks, dump trucks, excavators, and other construction equipment to complete the work. This may lead to the occurrence of noise, vibrations, dust, and site lighting.
- Crews will take steps to reduce disturbances as needed, including:
 - Pointing lights away from residential windows and public spaces.
 - Equipping vehicles and equipment with white noise backup alarms.
 - Non-idling of non-essential equipment.
 - Using water as needed to minimize any dust impacts.

TRAFFIC & PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Construction vehicles and equipment are expected within the immediate work area, Union and Townsley streets.
- Union St. segments of Union St may be obstructed overnight as vehicles enter and exist the rail corridor.
- Pedestrians will not be impacted during this work.
- No impact to scheduled GO trains.
- Please exercise caution around active construction sites.
- Work activities are subject to change.

HOURS OF WORK

- The minor track closure is scheduled from Friday, July 11, at 11:59 p.m. to Monday, July 14, at 5:00 a.m.
- Work will occur 24 hours a day during the scheduled track closure.
- Dump trucks will be entering and existing the corridor during nighttime hours from 1:30am to 4:30am to unload materials.
