

Overnight Grade Crossing Enhancements and Temporary Lane Closures near the Lakeshore East Rail Corridor

July 21, 2025 to Early August



This map is for illustrative purposes only. Work will proceed in stages, occupying one working area at a time.

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 train trips a week - so you won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid system.

What is happening?

As part of investigative work for the GO Expansion project, crews will be painting yellow high-visibility boxes onto the pavement near the Lakeshore East rail corridor grade crossings at Scarborough Golf Club Road, Manse Road, Beechgrove Dr, and Rodd Avenue. To improve roadway safety, this work will involve temporary partial lane closures to maintain a safe construction zone. Work will be carried out overnight when GO trains are not in service.

HOURS OF WORK

- Subsurface utility engineering, surveying and inspections are expected to take place Monday – Friday beginning as early as July 21, 2025, between 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. and will move within the areas highlighted on the map.
- This program is scheduled for completion over 10 days between July 21 and August 30, 2025.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Crews will be painting yellow high-visibility boxes onto the pavement near the grade crossings to enhance safety.
- Residents may observe crews working near the rail corridor and can expect some minor disturbances.
- Staff will take reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances to residents and commuters, including but not limited to the following:
 - Reduced idling of non-essential equipment.
 - Pointing lights away from residential windows.
 - Safely secured work areas.
- Work may take place within and outside of the rail corridor.
- Work taking place outside of Metrolinx property will have the required permits and approvals from municipal or regional authorities.

- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- We apologize for any inconvenience and ask for your patience as we complete this critical work.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS

- Temporary lane adjustments are required to complete this work safely.
- Traffic control persons will direct motorists safely around active work areas.
- One lane and sidewalk will remain open to motorists and pedestrians at all times in either direction.
- Work areas will be set up with clear delineation.
- There are no anticipated impacts to public transit.
- Please continue to exercise caution around active construction sites.
