What is Happening

• To prepare for future road diversions that will facilitate utility relocations as part of Scarborough Subway Extension construction, crews will be performing roadway and sidewalk construction and a fire hydrant relocation.

What to Expect

- Construction and paving equipment such as vacuum trucks, excavators, dump trucks, compactors/rollers and pavers will be used to remove and relocate sidewalks, curbs and gutters. Nearby residents and businesses may hear construction activity noise.
- Work will be completed in a phased approach, as identified in the above maps, to maintain flow of traffic, access to businesses, and public and worker safety. Not all lane restrictions and work areas will be present at any given time. Phase 1 will take approximately one week, and subsequent phases (2 through 4) will last approximately two weeks each.
- Throughout the project, when required, sidewalks will be rerouted or closed.
- We will ensure pedestrian, driver, and worker safety with the use of appropriate signage, traffic flaggers and/or paid duty officers, and barriers or fencing to define lanes, walkways and work areas.
- Northbound and southbound turns onto McCowan Road from Nugget Avenue will be maintained throughout all phases.
- Eastbound turns onto Nugget Avenue from McCowan Road will be maintained through all phases, with the exception of Phase 2.
- The northbound bus stop on McCowan Road at Nugget Avenue will be temporarily relocated to just north of the intersection.

About the Project

- A nearly eight-kilometre subway extension will extend Line 2 farther into Scarborough.
- Three new stops will have connections to up to six other transit options including TTC buses, GO train, GO buses, Line 5 Eglinton, Durham Region Transit, and the proposed Sheppard Extension.
- The extension will accommodate up to 105,000 daily boardings and put 34,000 more jobs within walking distance to rapid transit.
