

Subsurface utilities investigation on Pape Avenue south of Langley Avenue

Expected start date: As early as July 23, 2025

Expected duration: One day

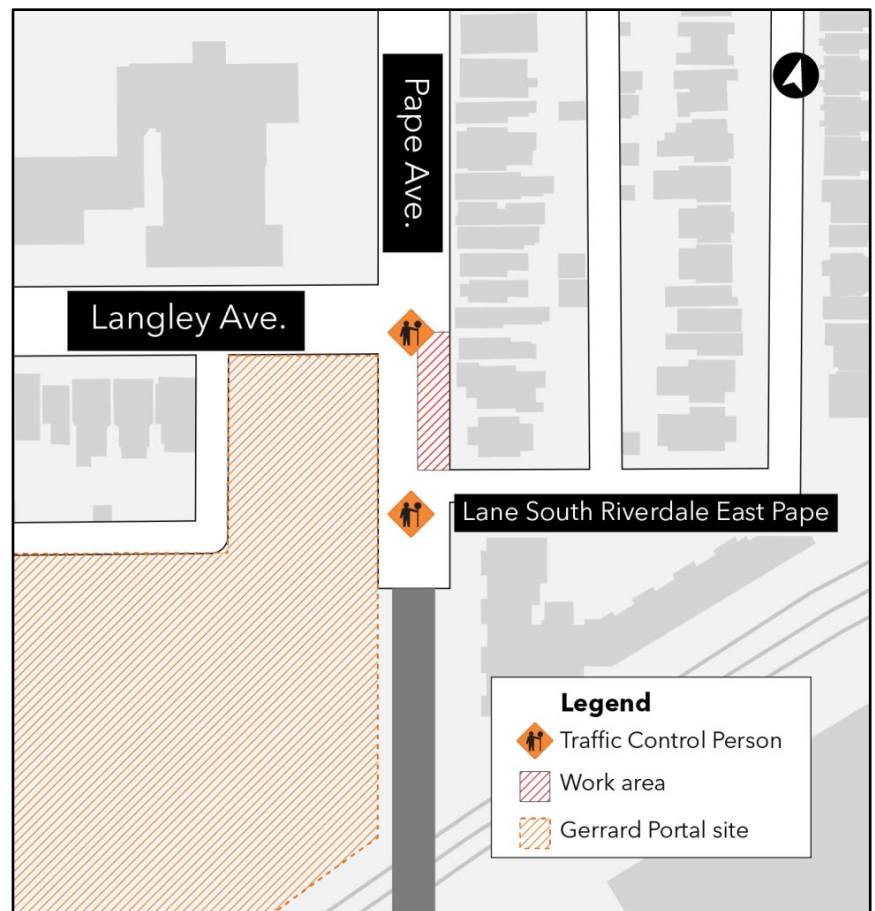
Hours of work: Monday to Friday: 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

What is happening?

- To enable future construction activities for the Ontario Line, crews will be conducting subsurface utilities investigations along Pape Avenue, south of Langley Avenue.
- Investigations consist of small test hole drilling on the road. Utilities investigations are essential to understanding the location and position of utilities that exist near the future Ontario Line tunnel alignment.

What to expect

- The east side lane (odd number side) of Pape Avenue will be closed for utility investigations.
- Access to Lane South Riverdale East Pape will be maintained. Traffic control personnel will assist drivers.
- Driveways may experience temporary disruptions, but access will be maintained.
- Traffic control personnel will be in place to assist residents with driveway access.
- A hydrovac may be on site, depending on the investigation work required.
- Signage will be in place to delineate work zones.
- During some phases of work, noise and dust from construction equipment is expected.



- Safety barriers will be placed around the maintenance hole or road cut area. The site will be supervised throughout the work.
- Traffic control personnel will be on-site managing traffic flow, if required.
- Underground utilities will be marked using temporary spray paint and chalk.
- Timing of construction is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.
