

Noise wall installation around Pape Station Site

Expected start date: Mid-July 2025

Expected duration: Installation will take approximately four weeks

Hours of work: Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What is happening?

- Starting in July 2025, new noise walls will be installed at various locations along the work site at Pape and Danforth. These walls are in addition to the existing noise walls, to further mitigate impact on the nearby community.
- Noise walls will be installed around Pape Station, Lipton Avenue, and along Eaton Avenue between Danforth Avenue and the pedestrian access to Pape Station.
- Installation will take place from Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.

- The purpose of the noise barriers will be to mitigate and contain noise and dust from the piling work. The barriers range from five to seven metres tall. Additional locations will be evaluated as needed.

What to expect

- Construction equipment will access the site from Danforth Avenue.
- Noise and vibration from construction equipment including hydrovacs, concrete trucks, and other machinery can be expected.
- Noise and vibration monitors are in place to ensure acceptable levels are maintained.
- Construction equipment and materials will be properly secured within the work zones.
- Work may be delayed due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
