UPDATE: Track Work Continues at Topflight Drive including Intersection Closure at Hurontario Street

July 2025 - mid-September 2025



What work is taking place?

Necessary track rework at the intersection of Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street, as well as on Topflight Drive, will continue until **mid-September 2025.** This track rework is being done to ensure safe operations of the future light rail vehicles and allow for vehicle testing in the future.

The work in the area will require a partial intersection closure at Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street, lane reductions on Hurontario Street and turning restrictions at Kingsway Drive and Hurontario Street. Traffic on Hurontario Street will be reduced to a single lane north and southbound from south of Highway 407 to Kingsway Drive. Detour routes for turning restrictions in place are available via Derry Road, Edwards Boulevard, and Derycrest Drive. All turning movements and lane reductions will be reinstated only when work at the intersection is completed. Track rework will also take place on Edwards Boulevard upon completion of these works, with scope and dates to be announced in the future.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained during these works but may require temporary restrictions or alternative access during this period. On-site crews will support traffic movements on Topflight Drive to and from businesses.

Construction work in the area is scheduled to take place on Monday to Sunday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m., with most days concluding at 7 p.m. There may be occasional days in which late night or overnight work is required. The project team



will provide nearby stakeholders with notification if this is to be scheduled. Access for emergency vehicles will only be maintained via the detour routes. Traffic signals at the intersection of Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street will be deactivated, and other signals will be adjusted to keep traffic flowing. Pedestrian east-west crossings will be prohibited at Topflight Drive as well as the north crosswalk at Kingsway Drive. The east sidewalk along Hurontario Street from north of Topflight Drive will be closed. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Please see roadway signage for the latest information. TIMING

- Track work at Topflight Drive and Hurontario Street continues until mid-September 2025.
- Construction work in the area is scheduled to take place on Monday to Sunday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m, with most days concluding at 7 p.m.
- There may be occasional days when late night or overnight work is required.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Businesses near work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.
- Please note: Edwards Boulevard segment will have to be done after Topflight Drive works are completed. Scope and dates are to be announced, and notification will be sent at later date.

TRANSIT IMPACT DETAILS

- Please visit MiWay.ca, BramptonTransit.com and gotransit.com for updates on your bus route.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- East side of Hurontario Street and Topflight Drive intersection to be closed fully for all road users. Traffic signals will be deactivated.
- Topflight Drive only be accessible from Edwards Boulevard, including for emergency vehicles.
- There will be no east/west crosswalk at the Topflight Drive intersection, as well as the north leg of Kingsway Drive intersection.
- Lane reductions on Hurontario Street spans between south of Highway 407 to Kingsway Drive.
- Traffic delays are expected. Signal timings in the area will be adjusted.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.
