



for the reconstruction of
platforms within the existing
trainshed, and to optimize the
overall On-Corridor Works
construction schedule.

The USEP is required in addition to the rehabilitation and upgrades already completed or near completion at Union Station.



TRACK LEVEL - WEST OF YORK ST (AREA A)


Track Level

- Mechanical Room 4
 - Cap beam installation on secant wall
 - Rebar for the cap beam installation is underway
 - Concrete pouring for the cap beam is in progress, being completed in several layers

Next steps: Second layer of the cap beam concrete pour, once complete; excavation further to final grade


TRACK LEVEL - YORK STREET TEAMWAYS (AREA B)


York West Teamway

- Preparation for Enwave
 - Anticipated start of Enwave scope of work: TBD
 - Potential Impacts:
 - Full closure of the south side of the YWT
 - Pedestrians to be re-routed to sidewalk outside of the teamway
 - Duration: 4+ months
- Concourse Pour Prep
 - Electrical conduit installations and mechanical installations, and backfilling are ongoing
 - **Next steps:** backfilling, followed by vapor barrier, rebar and formwork installations

York East Teamway

- Pile cap installations
 - **Next step:** reinforcement and grounding installations leading up to the pile cap installation in mid August

North West


- Methane piping and vapor barrier installations are ongoing

 Excavation for grade beam installations and chipping of the York St. abutment





TRUCK TUNNEL (AREA D)


- Fire Shutter Door 2 Installation
 - Schedule: TBD
- Truck Tunnel Roof Demolition
 - Anticipated start date of north flare demo: August 29th
 - Work hours: 5:00PM 2:00AM
 - Work to be completed within OTA construction site

TRUCK TUNNEL (AREA D)




TRACK LEVEL - AREA E

South side

- Building Mechanical Room 1
 - Slab on grade pour complete
 - Rebar and formwork installations for the suspended slab is ongoing
 - Chipping is underway at the southwest corner as part of the truck tunnel demolition prep work
 - **Next steps:** Cap beam installation

North side

- Concrete pouring, rebar and formwork activities are underway
 - Next steps: Cap beam installation, backfilling, rebar and formwork






Photo: Area E Mechanical Room Progress (east facing)

TRACK LEVEL - AREAS F/G

South side


- Pile cap and grade beam installations and detailing are ongoing
- Caisson chipping is underway
- Rebar installations, formwork and concrete pouring are in progress

North side

- Demolition works underway
 - Handchipping of existing caissons to final elevation
- Pile cap installations are ongoing incl. excavation for future pile caps and SOE installations
- Duct bank installation leading into Mechanical Room 2 is in progress

Mechanical Room 2

- Column installations, duct bank installations, and trenching for sanitary installations are ongoing
 - Next steps: Methane and electrical installations, concrete pouring, then backfilling






Photo: Area F/G - South wall - duct bank installation

TRACK LEVEL - AREA F/G

- Electrical Relocations
 - 120V relocation investigations late August
- Manhole investigations on Bay St. is on hold further investigations are underway
 - Scotia Bank Galleria manhole investigation proposed schedule: Friday, Sep 13 – Sunday, Sep 15
- Blue Route Investigations
 - Design and work plan discussions + site walks with stakeholders

TRACK LEVEL - AREA I/J

Area I

North side:

• Micropile and pile cap detailing are in progress

South side:

- Support of excavation installations and deep excavation is ongoing
- Wingwall demolition (southwest corner) is complete and postal tunnel footing demolition is ongoing
- Archaeological investigations are cleared for removal
- Tiebacks on the west side are underway

Area J

- Grade beam installation is complete and shoring installations at the Bay St Bridge is ongoing
 - Next steps: Demolition of the concrete abutment façade to begin this week, followed by wiresawing to create an opening






Photo: Area I: Excavation in the south, pile cap work in the north




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
