





overall On-Corridor Works
construction schedule.

The USEP is required in addition to the rehabilitation and upgrades already completed or near completion at Union Station.






TRACK LEVEL - WEST OF YORK ST (AREA A)

Track Level

Mechanical Room 4

- Foundation work on hold for caisson investigations
- Abutment demolition is underway
 - Large opening nearing completion
 - Estimated completion: Early February

Next steps: Rubble removal following the abutment opening completion, subgrade installation






Photo: Area A - Mechanical Room 4 (west facing)


TRACK LEVEL - YORK STREET TEAMWAYS (AREA B)

York West Teamway (YWT)

- Enwave Scope
 - Ongoing until April 2025
 - Full closure of the south side of the YWT
 - Pedestrians to be re-routed to sidewalk outside of the teamway
- Large opening into Area A (Mechanical Room 4) is ongoing
- · Ramp and guard rail installation as well as hoarding installation is ongoing
 - **Next steps**: Demolition and excavation for the trench pipe installations

York East Teamway

• Abutment demolition is complete, next steps are prep for the slab installation

TRACK LEVEL - EAST OF YORK ST (AREA C)

North side

Stripping of the track slab formwork is complete

Southwest side

- Abutment demolition is complete
- Area cleanup is underway
 - Next Steps: column extension installations, install grounding, plumbing and lower concourse slab installations






Photo: Area C – Abutment Wire Sawing

TRUCK TUNNEL (AREA D)

Truck Tunnel Roof Demolition

- Day and night shifts, within OTA construction site
- Demolition is underway on the south portion
 - North flare demolition complete
 - Next steps: Demolition of the remaining center portion (estimated completion - late February 2025)

South Flare Man Door Opening

Drilling is ongoing, to be followed by wire-sawing the perimeter








TRACK LEVEL - AREA E

- Decking installation is underway across the north and center of the area
 - **Next steps**: Conduit and rebar installations

Mechanical Room 1

- Walls and columns above the suspended slab are complete
 - Next Steps: surveying, mechanical and electrical conduit installations, reinforcement, and track slab pour in late February/early March






Photo: Area E - Track Slab Decking Installation Underway





TRACK LEVEL - AREAS F/G

South Side


- Cistern has been installed
- Final tie-in and concrete pouring of surrounding walls ongoing, followed by backfilling, then a suspended slab
- Wheelchair ramp along the south wall is underway, rebar installations and formwork to be installed followed by concrete pouring
- Rebar and formwork installation across the south for walls is ongoing, expected to pour in within the coming weeks

North Side

- Clear stone backfilling is underway
- Concrete poured at the bases of one of the atrium supports, to be completed at the other atrium support

Mechanical Room 2

- Column and wall installations are ongoing
- Concrete pad poured for a mechanical ventilation unit installed
 - **Next steps**: Suspended slab preparation






Photo: Area F/G - Cistern Installed



Design and work plan discussions are underway






Photo: Blue Route openings on the West Wall

Area is **ON HOLD** for caisson investigations






Photo: Area J: Abutment chipping (southeast facing)




