- Be open and receptive to ideas.
- Liaise and act as a representative of pre-identified organization/community/business or stakeholder group by providing feedback to the project team and formally communicating relevant information back to their respective groups.
- Adhere to all aspects of the Terms of Reference and Code of Conduct.



Project Update – Package BWoodbine Avenue to Warden Avenue

PROJECT CONSTRUCTION MILESTONES



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Wolcott Ave. to Warden Ave.

Piling works in the areas shown on the map, starting approximately mid-November:

- 1. Daytime piling for 6 weeks.
- 2. Overnight caisson piling for one week followed by daytime work for one further week.
- Overnight driven piling for one week followed by daytime work for five weeks.
- 4. Overnight caisson piling for one week followed by daytime work for one week.




Duration: ~16 weeks

Day and night shift

Warden Bridge Piling – traffic impacts





Warden Ave. to Victoria Park Ave.

- Ground improvement works continuing, duration approx. 10 weeks;
- Followed by drill rig installation and piling for Retaining wall 2 (RW2), will include excavation and tiebacks.
 Earthworks will start after temporary shoring is complete
- Duration: ~17 months
- Day and night shifts



Victoria Park Ave. to Main St. (South Side of the Corridor)

North side:

• Grading and installation of soakaway pits (drainage measure) currently underway

Pad construction

South side:

- Earthworks: Final grading and sub-ballast installation
- Soakaway pits
- Duration: ~ 2 months
- Day and night shifts



Main St. to Woodbine Ave.

- Continued installation of the soakaway pits (drainage measure);
- Final grading to follow on the north side of the raceway;
- Duration: ~3 months
