Community Representatives or Area Residents and Businesses will:

- Participate actively in regular meetings.
- Be open and receptive to ideas.
- Liaise and act as a representative of pre-identified organization/community/business or stakeholder group by providing feedback to the project team and formally communicating relevant information back to their respective groups.
- Adhere to all aspects of the Terms of Reference and Code of Conduct.

During the partial closure, we will always keep one side of the central pier open to traffic and pedestrians, keeping one lane of traffic flowing in each direction and the sidewalk.




Warden Ave. to Victoria Park Ave.
